The following statistics were released today by NHS England:

NHS cancelled elective operations, quarter ending 30 June 2014

The key points from the latest release are:

- During the quarter ending 30 June 2014, 15,661 operations were cancelled at the last minute for non-clinical reasons by NHS providers. In the same period in 2013/14, there were 15,443 cancelled operations.
- Cancelled operations during the quarter represented 0.8% of all elective activity, compared to 0.8% in the same period in 2013/14.
- Of these cancellations 804 (5.1%) of patients were not treated within 28 days of a cancellation. In the same period in 2013/14, 1,079 (7.0%) of patients were not treated within 28 days.
