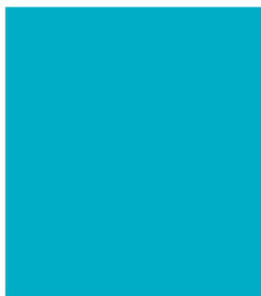

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## 12 week risk assessment context



All women should be encouraged to access maternity services for a full health and social care assessment of needs, risks and choices by 12 completed weeks of their pregnancy to give them the full benefit of personalised maternity care and improve outcomes and experience for mother and baby.

Reducing the percentage of women who access maternity services later in pregnancy through targeted outreach work for vulnerable and socially excluded groups will help to reduce the health inequalities these groups face whilst also guaranteeing choice to all pregnant women.

## 12 week risk assessment summary of results



The Q1-4 2013/14 collection of 12 week risk assessment, breastfeeding Initiation and 6-8 week breastfeeding data was collected directly from maternity service providers and child health information system providers.

138 maternity providers were identified for 12 week & breastfeeding initiation submissions. We have received data returns covering 127 of these providers Q1-3, an uptake rate of 92%, for Q4 129 providers submitted data, an uptake rate of 93%.

The level of maternity provider submissions at Q4 was 18-19% higher than during the pilot submission of Q1-3 data.

As data submissions were below 95% we do not have sufficient data coverage to publish an England figure for the Q1-4 2013/14 at this stage.

### 12 week risk assessment

In England the Q1-2 2013/14 percentage seen before 12 week and 6 days was not published due to low data coverage. In 2011/12 Q4 the percentage seen before 12 week and 6 days was (95.1%), compared with 2010/11 Q4 (92.3%), 2009/10 Q4 (87.0%) (Table 1).

In England amongst the 139 CCGs that passed validation, the percentage seen before 12 week and 6 days ranged from 1.2% in NHS Slough CCG to 173.0%\* in North Tyneside CCG and the percentage of maternities that were seen after 12 weeks and 6 days ranged from 0.6% in Southend CCG to 243.9%\* in Stoke On Trent CCG (Table 3).

In England amongst the 116 NHS Trusts that passed validation in Q2 2013/14, the percentage seen before 12 week and 6 days ranged from 17.8% Dartford and Gravesham NHS Trust to 278.0%\* in County Durham and Darlington NHS Foundation Trust and the percentage of maternities that were seen after 12 weeks and 6 days ranged from 1.3% in Nottingham University Hospitals NHS Trust to 314.7%\* in St George's Healthcare NHS Trust (Table 2).

*\* For 12 week risk assessment some recorded figures are greater than 100% of maternities. The reason for greater than 100% recording can be traced to two possible causes.*

*Firstly that the indicator definition compares bookings for mothers having assessments at a trust to the number of maternities at the point of delivery at that trust 2 quarters later. However the maternity at the point of delivery figure may be lower than the number of mothers having assessments due to mothers suffering miscarriage, women choosing to undergo a termination or women transferring to another hospital.*

*Secondly that women who live in urban areas where there are multiple hospitals they could chose to delivery at often chose to undergo assessments at more than one hospital to enable them to compare maternity service provision. As a result women may be double counted, leading to a higher ratio of assessments to deliveries.*

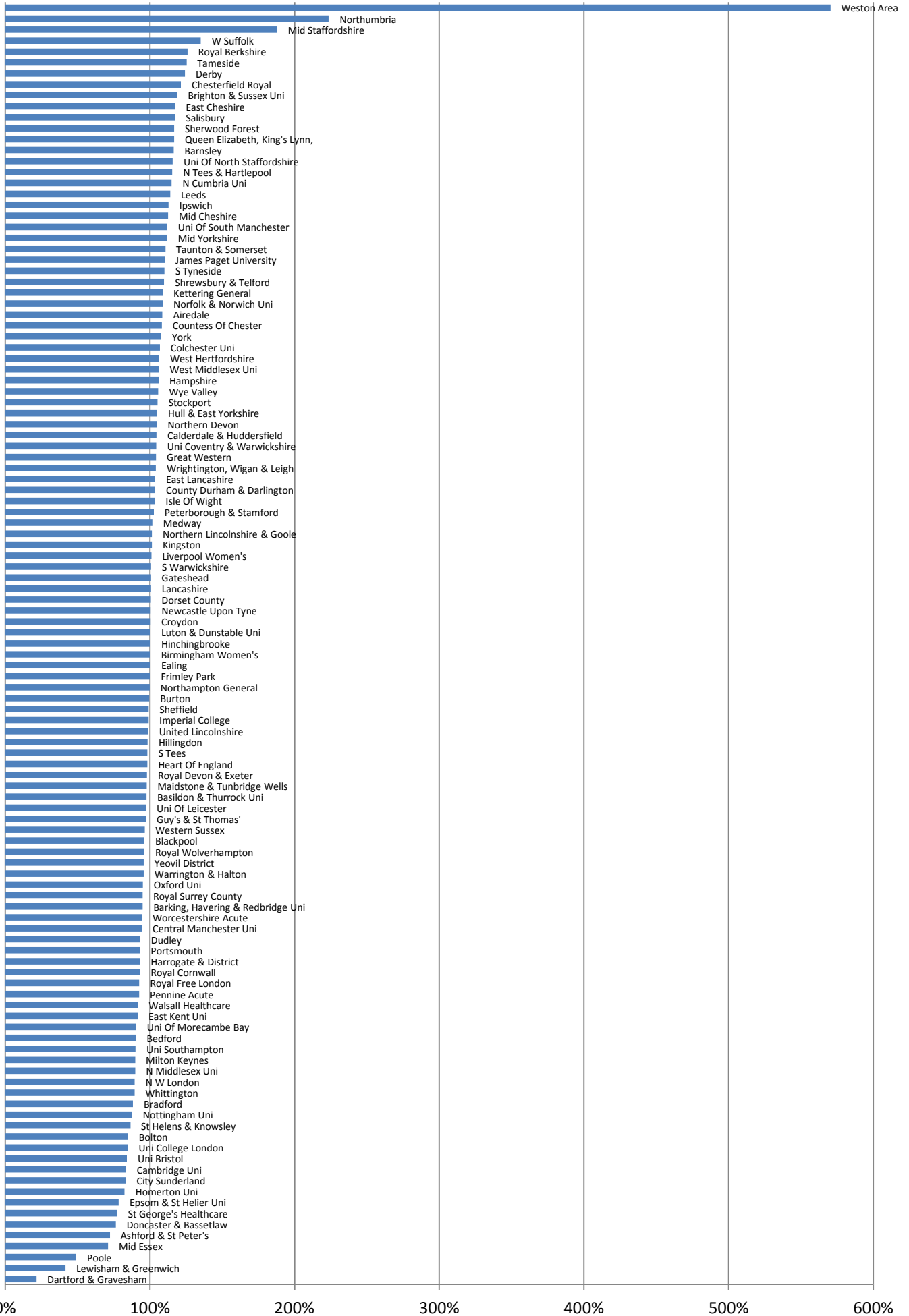

## Number of women seen after 12 weeks and 6 days of pregnancy as a percentage of the number of maternities by NHS Trusts in England 2013/14 Q2

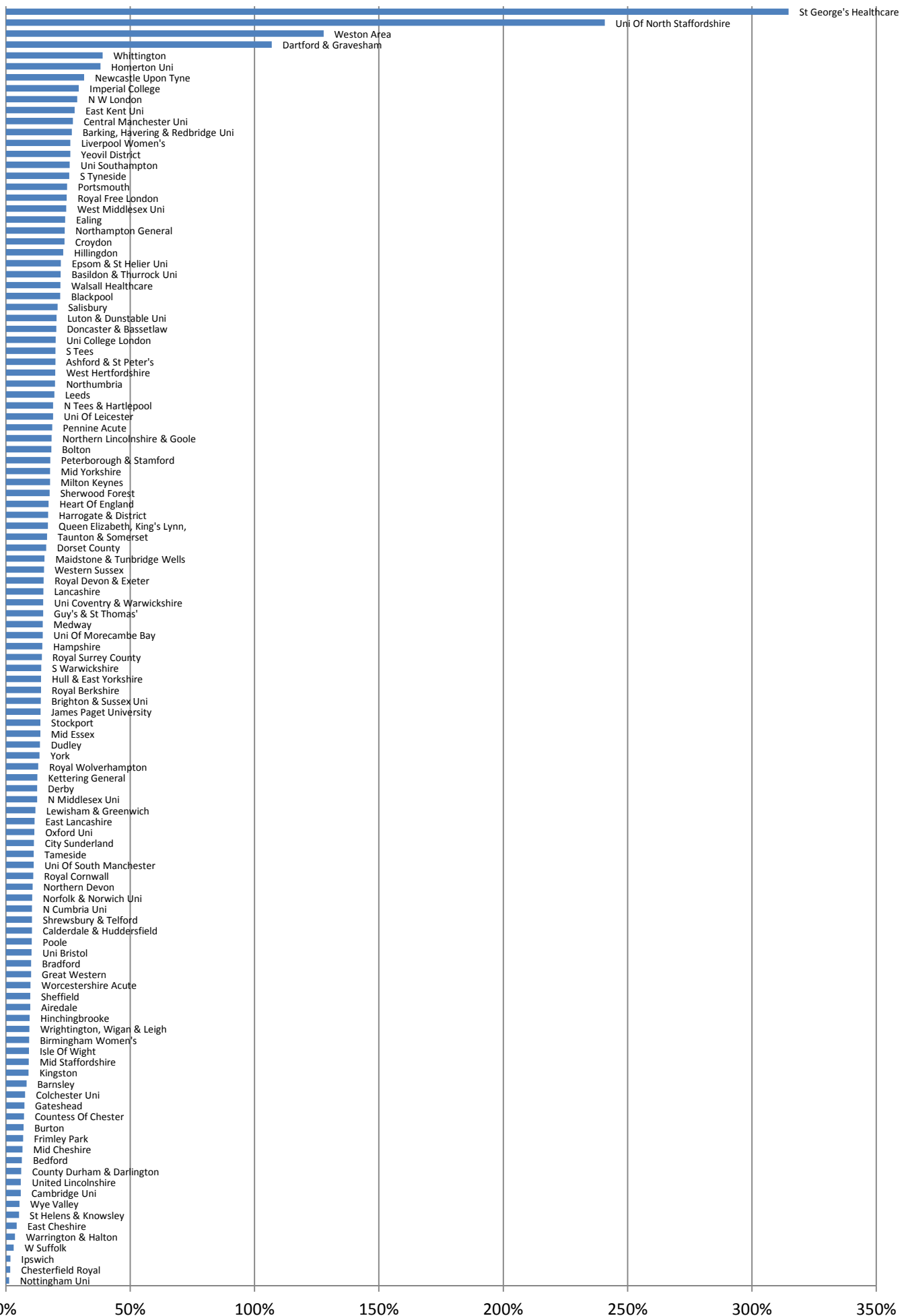

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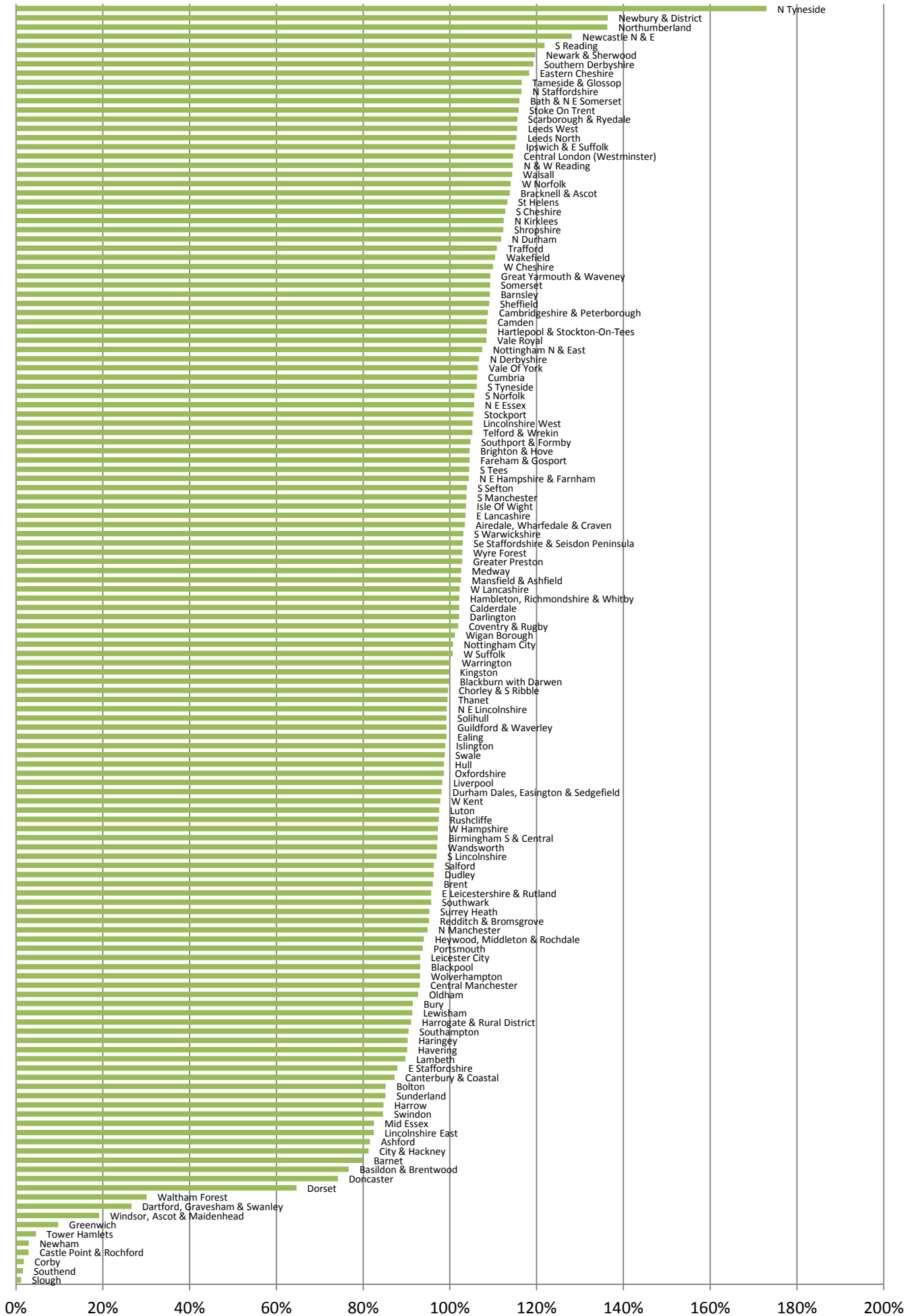

## Number of women seen after 12 weeks and 6 days of pregnancy as percentage of maternities by CCGs in England 2013/14 Q2

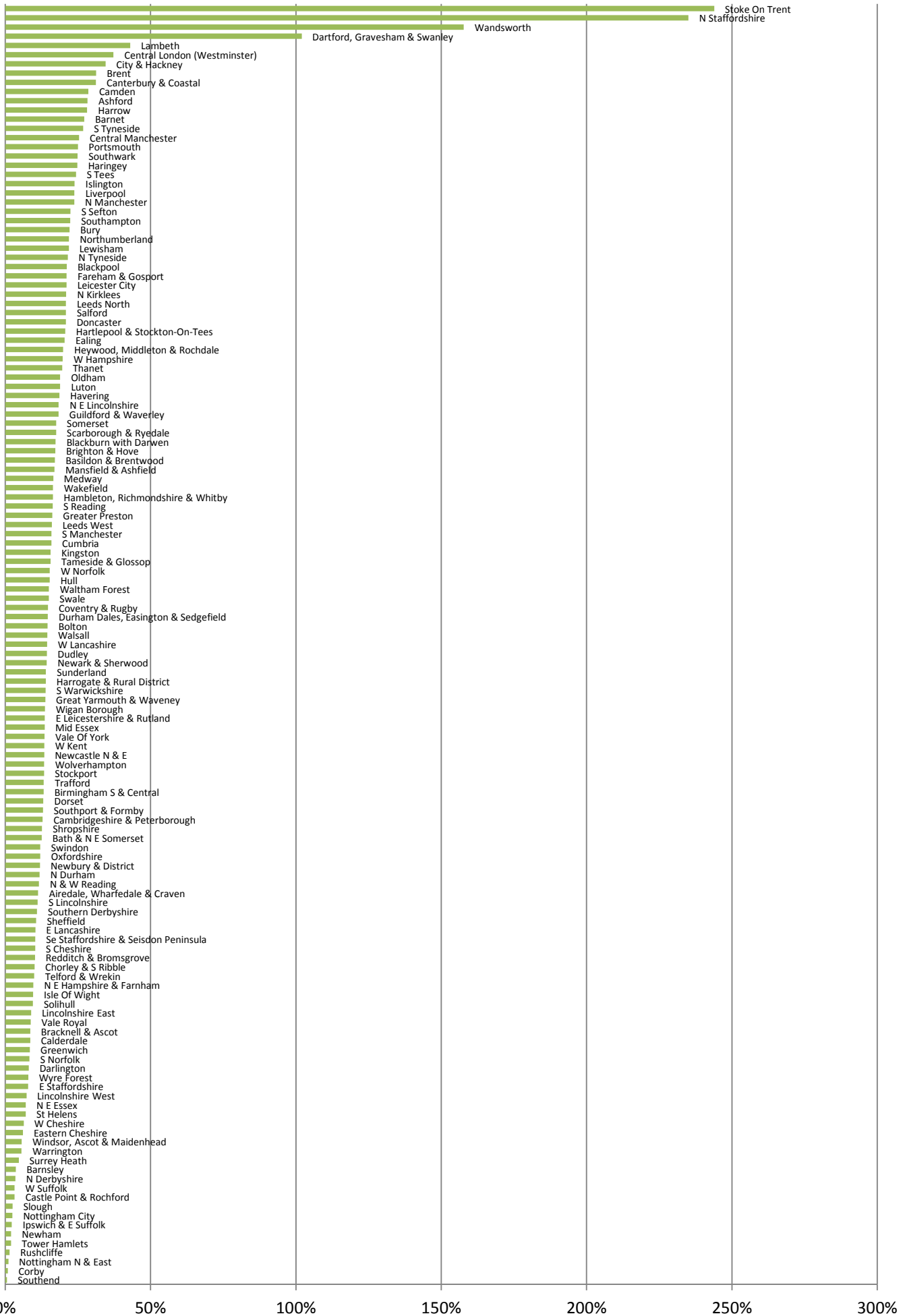

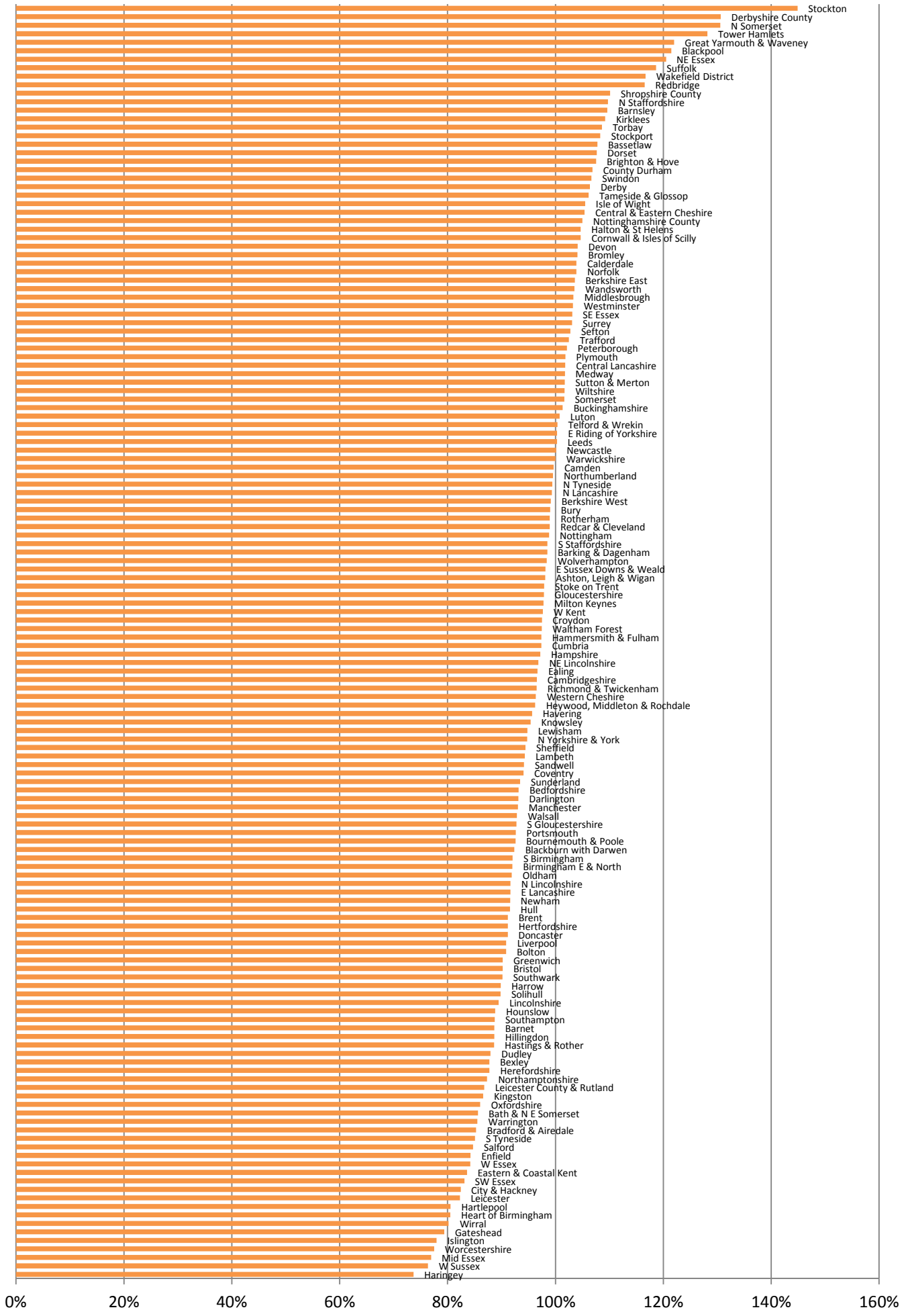




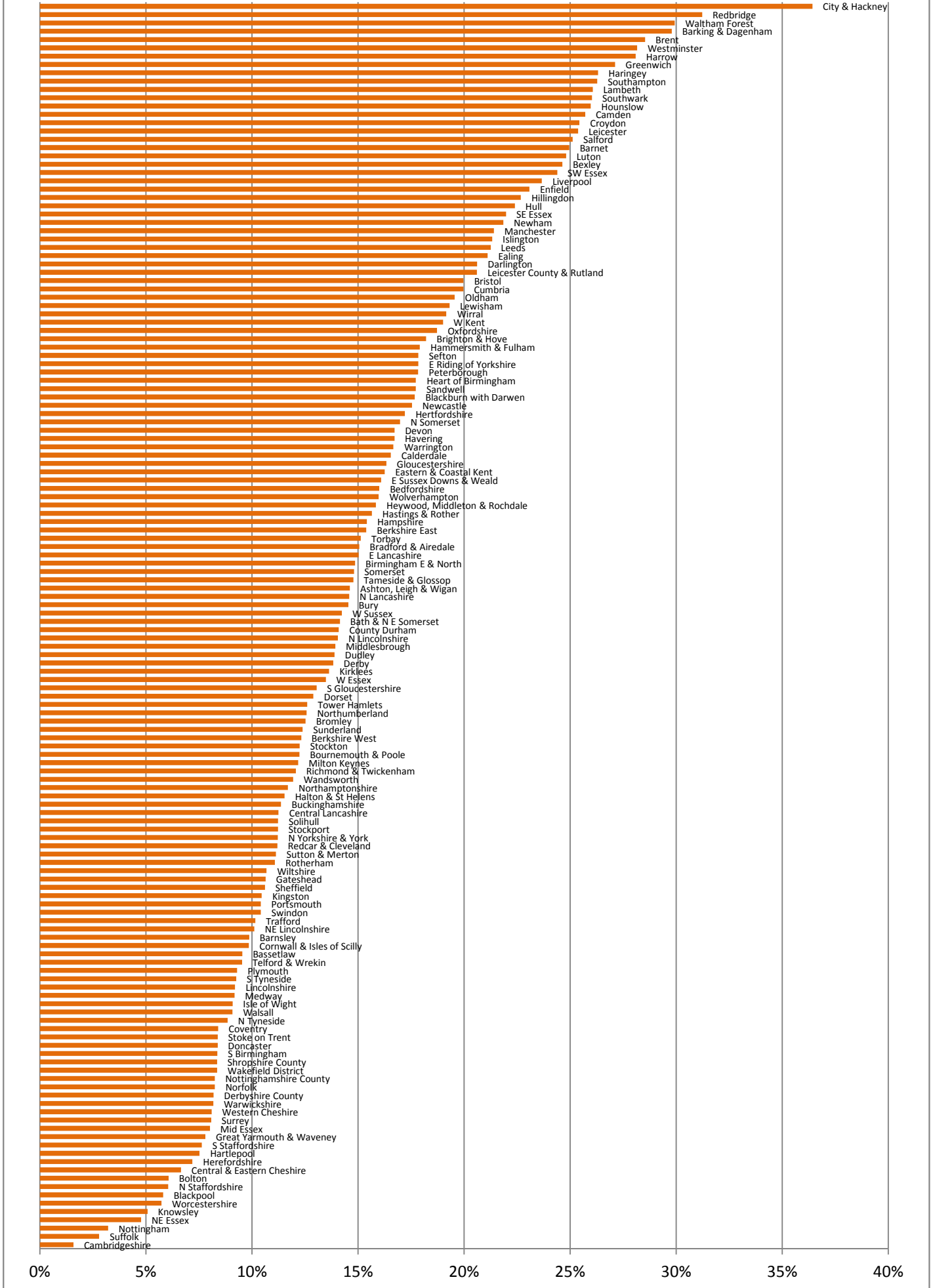




**Fig 5 : Number of women seen by 12 weeks and 6 days of pregnancy as a percentage of the number of maternities by PCTs in England 2012/13 Q2**

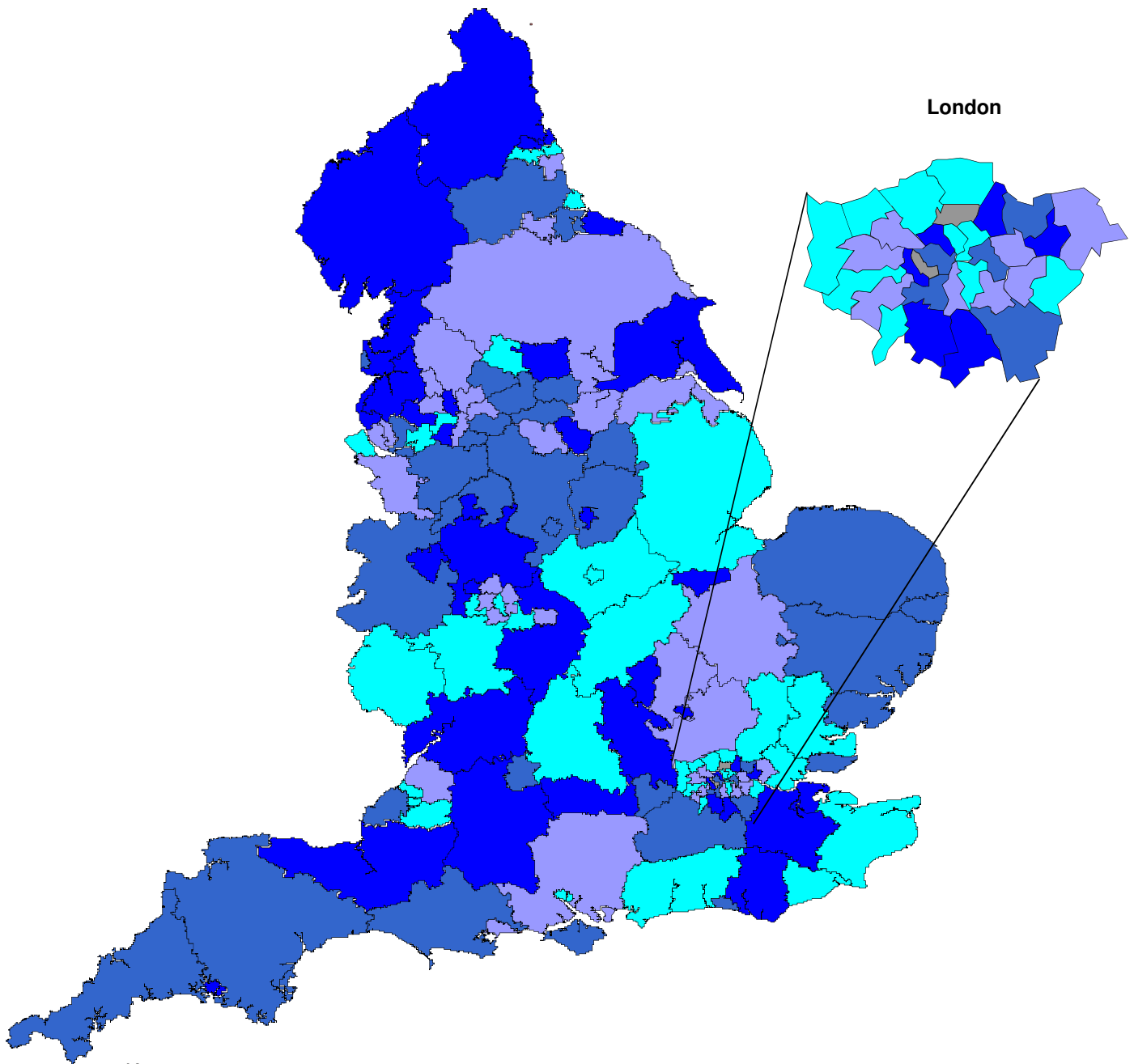


**Fig 6 : Number of women seen after 12 weeks and 6 days of pregnancy as percentage of the number of maternities by PCTs in England 2012/13 Q2**





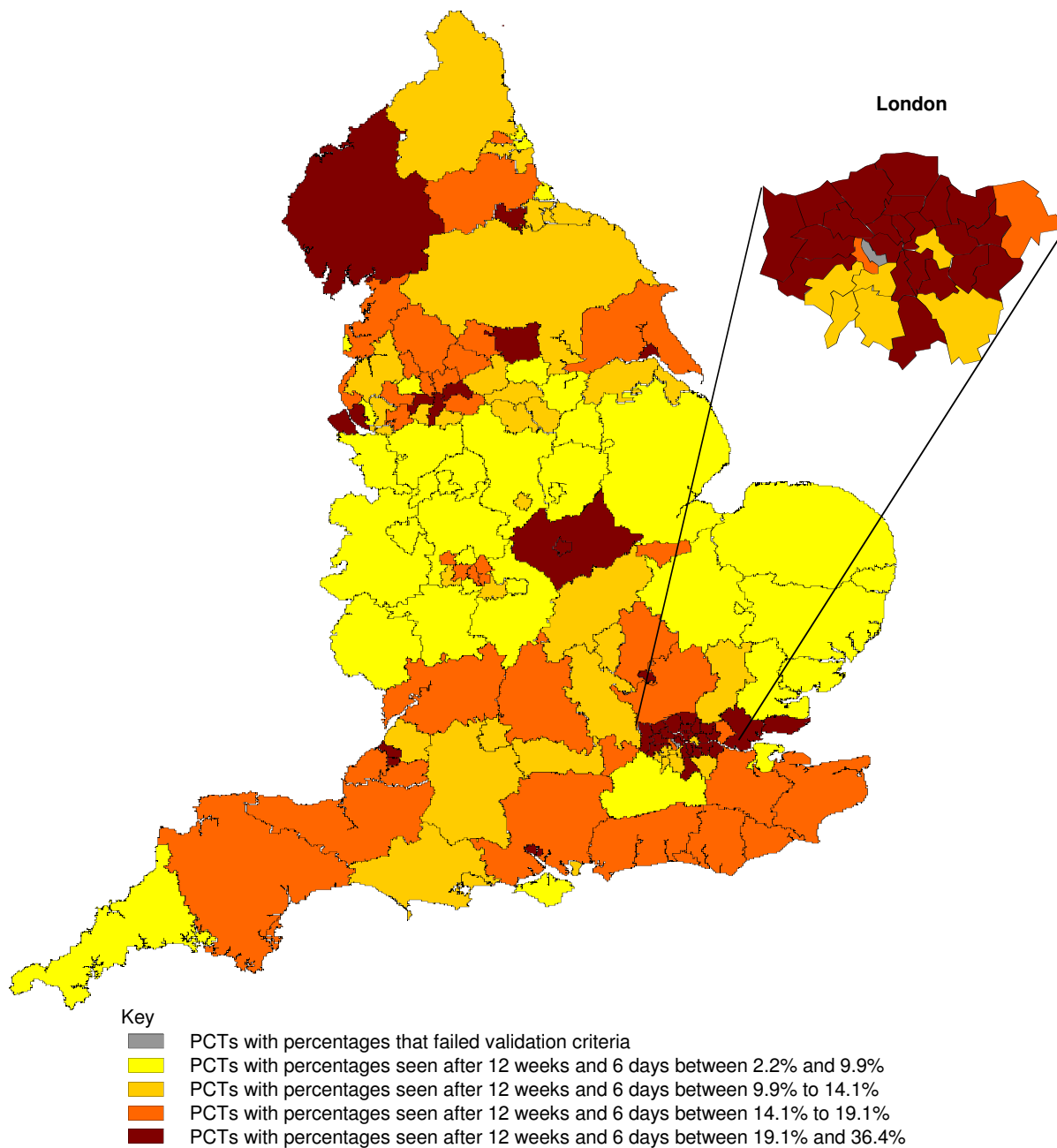

- PCTs with percentages seen after 12 weeks and 6 days between 75.0% and 90.2%
- PCTs with percentages seen after 12 weeks and 6 days between 90.2% to 97.4%

### High number of assessments:

RN7 DARTFORD AND GRAVESHAM NHS TRUST, RJ7 ST GEORGE'S HEALTHCARE NHS TRUST, RJE UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL OF NORTH STAFFORDSHIRE NHS TRUST high assessment figures were flagged as part of Q1-3 data assessment, these trusts resubmitted Q1-3 data at Q4 and assessment figures remain much higher than the number of maternities.

RJD Mid Staffordshire NHS Foundation Trust trust informed of high assessment figures compared to maternities at Q1-3, trust investigating data system.

RA3 Weston Area Health NHS Trust operate a shared care service where local women receive antenatal care from WAHT midwives but most deliver at units in Bristol. This means that the number of women assessed by WAHT will always exceed the number delivering. Due to the relatively small numbers of Maternities/ deliveries, 1 patient can represent 1.5% to 2% of WAHT quarterly total.

RTF Northumbria Healthcare NHS Trust, high proportion of the women they assess and provide community antenatal (and postnatal) care for do not deliver with the trust, but deliver with Newcastle Hospitals (RTD).

## Data collection and definition



### 12 week risk assessment

Since April 2013 this data is now being collected directly from providers via the data collection tool that is part of Unify2, a web based system set up to collect performance and other central returns directly from the NHS. The figures are obtained from maternity providers from midwives in acute trusts and information recorded at deliveries.

For 12 week assessment, each provider is required to submit actual figures for the quarter and year end out turn figures for the following three items:

The following items of information are to be submitted:

1. Number of women in the relevant GP population who have seen a midwife or a maternity healthcare professional, for health and social care assessment of needs, risks and choices by 12 weeks and 6 days of pregnancy
2. Number of women in the relevant GP population who have seen a midwife or a maternity healthcare professional, for health and social care assessment of needs, risks and choices at any time during pregnancy

### Data validation

The following validation rules are applied to the data  
All numbers must be submitted as integers.

Number of pregnant women due a maternity check	>=	Number of pregnant women who have seen a midwife or a maternity healthcare professional, for health and social care assessment of needs, risks and choices by 12 weeks and 6 days of pregnancy
Number of pregnant women due a maternity check	<	Maximum National Statistics (ONS) reported number of live births for the last year PLUS 20.0%
Number of pregnant women due a maternity check	>	Minimum National Statistics (ONS) reported number of live births for the last year MINUS 10.0%

All validation checks must be passed by Providers in order for the data to meet departmental statistical requirements. Where information has not passed these validation checks, this is identified in the tables in this report by conditional formatting.
