# The AAC priorities

The five priority areas for the AAC were agreed by the Board in November 2021 and describe our ambition:

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## NHS as a platform for research and innovation



### Research

*Increase scale, diversity and speed*

**Research:** increasing the diversity, scale, and speed of research, so that the NHS can have clinical evidence that better reflects our population and makes it easier to adopt innovations that will improve outcomes and address health inequalities



### Innovation

*Workforce championing*

**Innovation:** supporting the NHS workforce to champion innovation on the front line, so that they are better able to both develop and rapidly evaluate solutions (such as remote home monitoring) and to drive local implementation of new innovations



### NICE uptake

*Supporting uptake from ideation to adoption*

**Uptake of medicines and MedTech:** ensuring we have programmes to support the uptake of NICE-approved, proven innovation in the NHS. This supports work to improve the innovation pathway from ideation to adoption across medicines, diagnostics, medical devices, and digital products

## Targeting buying power at biggest opportunities



### DS/HS

*Clearly articulate NHS needs and opportunities*

**Horizon Scanning and Demand Signalling:** providing a clearer articulation of NHS needs (demand signalling) and matching this to a systematic search for solutions (horizon scanning), so that the NHS can plan and prepare for the next generation of innovations and stimulate innovation in the highest-priority areas



### Deals

*Delivering transformational commercial deals at scale*

**Deals and at scale solutions:** continuing our collaborative approach to transforming patient care with our AAC partners, through transparent and at-scale commercial deals that link to our demand signalling and horizon scanning, and supporting innovators to navigate the NHS, through the launch of the NHS Innovation Service and working locally with AHSNs






X-cutting delivery

Tackling health inequalities, Patient public participation, supporting NHSE clinical priorities, Life Sciences Vision, Net zero
