The paediatric surgical units at GOSH, Newcastle and Birmingham Children's Hospital have all been engaged in the writing of the policy statement.
How have stakeholders been involved? What engagement methods have been used?	Policy working group meeting and subsequent contact for policy development. Stakeholder engagement process. 14 day email engagement exercise with registered stakeholders.
What has happened or changed as a result of their input?	The responses from all stakeholders were supportive of adoption of the urgent policy statement. One stakeholder noted the importance of patient/carer engagement in the development of the patient's management plan and the need to properly consent patients. This comment was noted but no amendments were proposed to the urgent policy statement.
How are stakeholders being kept informed of progress with policy development as a result of their input?	Stakeholder can be contacted once a decision has been taken on the agreement of the urgent policy statement.
