

The childhood routine immunisation changes start on 1st July 2025.

In the East of England, DBS tests for the selective Hep B pathway will continue to be done by the Community School Aged Immunisation Service.

Children born **on or before 30 June 2024** should continue to be offered a dose of monovalent HepB vaccine and tested for (DBS) HBsAg on or after their first birthday (alongside Hib/MenC and other vaccines offered at this age. An 18-month DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB vaccine is not required).
