- By the end of week 1, 250 Pharmacies were signed up and 700 consultations had taken place. By the 31<sup>st</sup> March for minor ailments 4727 consultations had taken place.
- Area Team has agreed to extend until 30<sup>th</sup> June.
- Figures high within Stoke because they already have a MAS in place
- Face to face promotion with pharmacies may have had a further impact and there may have been some reluctance due to the time constraints of the scheme.

## **Professional Leadership**

#### **Mental Health**

- Met 1<sup>st</sup> April.
- 3 events are taking place 1 Staffordshire, 1 Shropshire, and 1 in Newcastle focusing on managing patients with mental health issues.

  - Interventions to support individuals who are likely to stop taking their meds.

Outcomes. **Pharmacy Interface** Apologies received from Julie Lomas, working group notes were distributed with the agenda.
