






Inactivated Influenza Vaccine PGD V08.00: Extension of eligible cohorts

This document provides confirmation that the use of the Inactivated Influenza Vaccine PGD V08.00, PHE publications gateway number: GW-1533, valid from 1 September 2020 to 31 March 2021, may be extended to the following eligible individuals:

- from mid-November, once Fluarix® Tetra is available to be ordered from ImmForm, children eligible for the Routine Childhood Seasonal Influenza Vaccination Programme who do not accept live attenuated influenza vaccine (LAIV) due to porcine gelatine content
- from 1 December 2020, people aged 50 to 65 years¹
