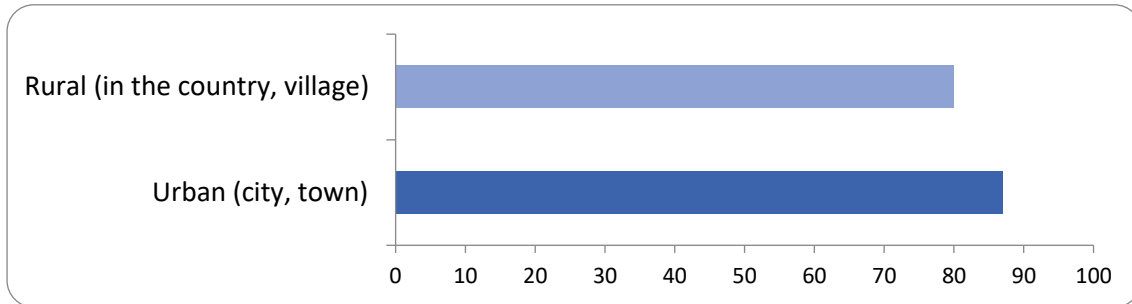

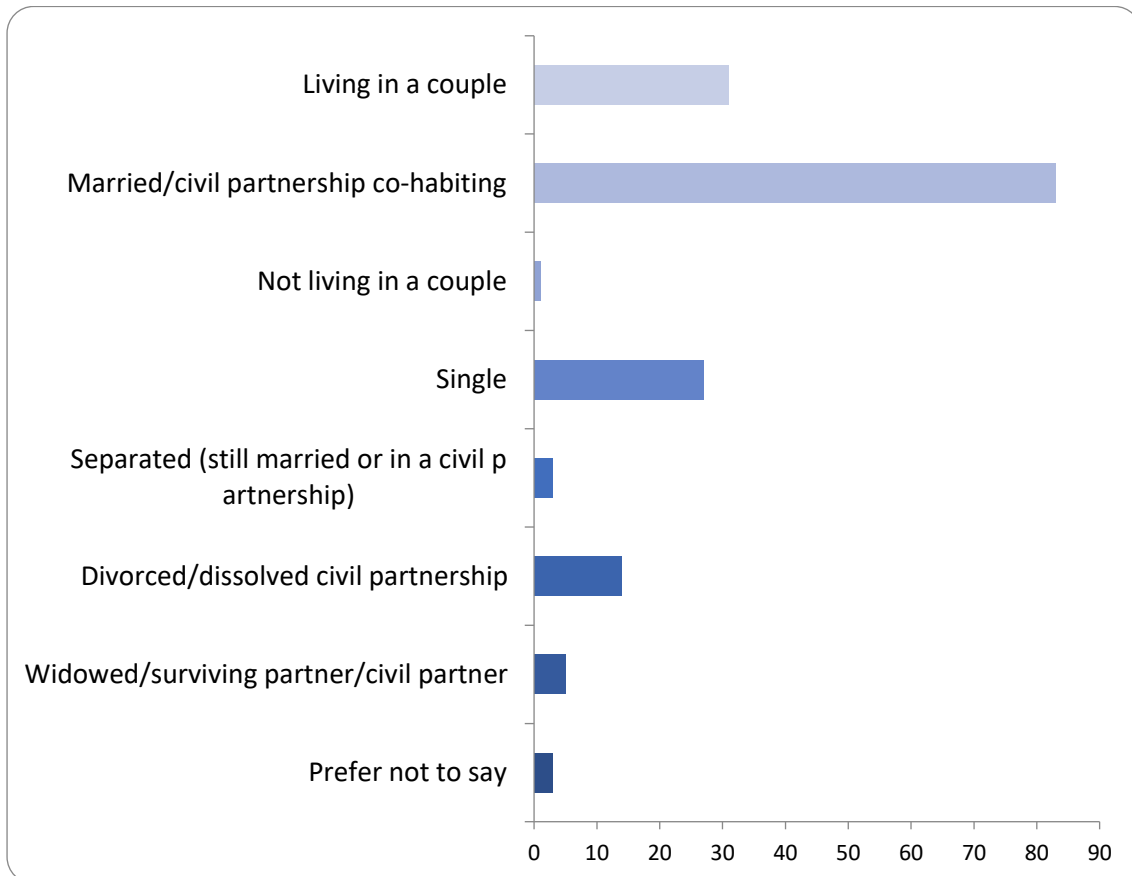
1.1 Where do you live?

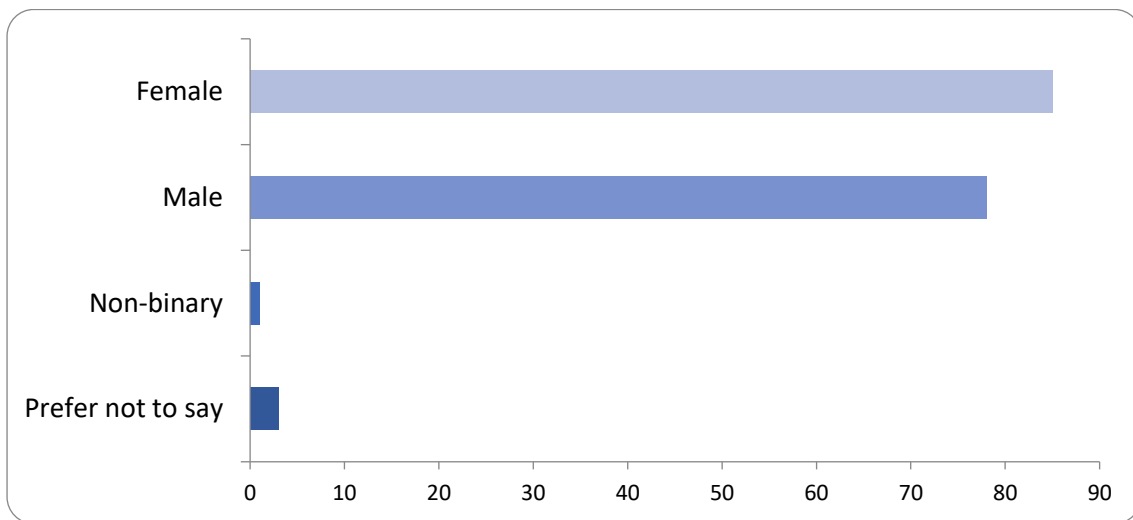
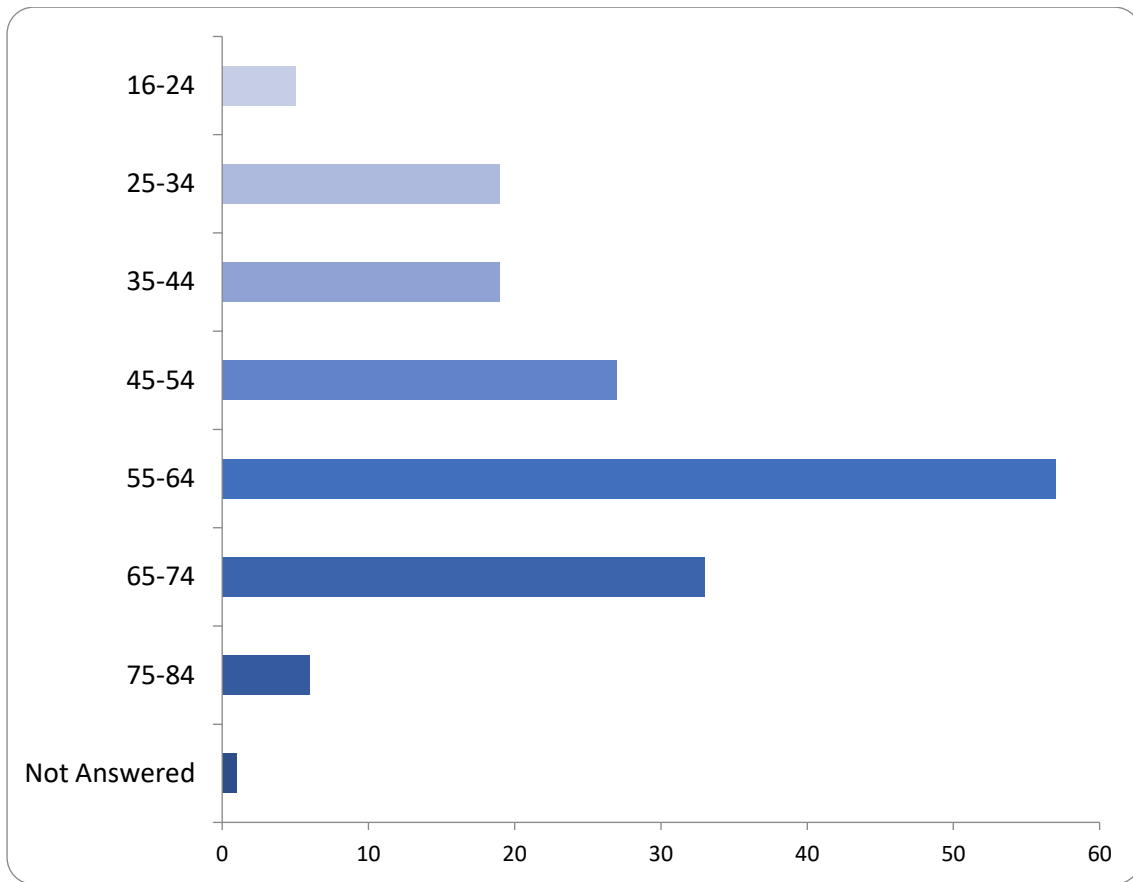

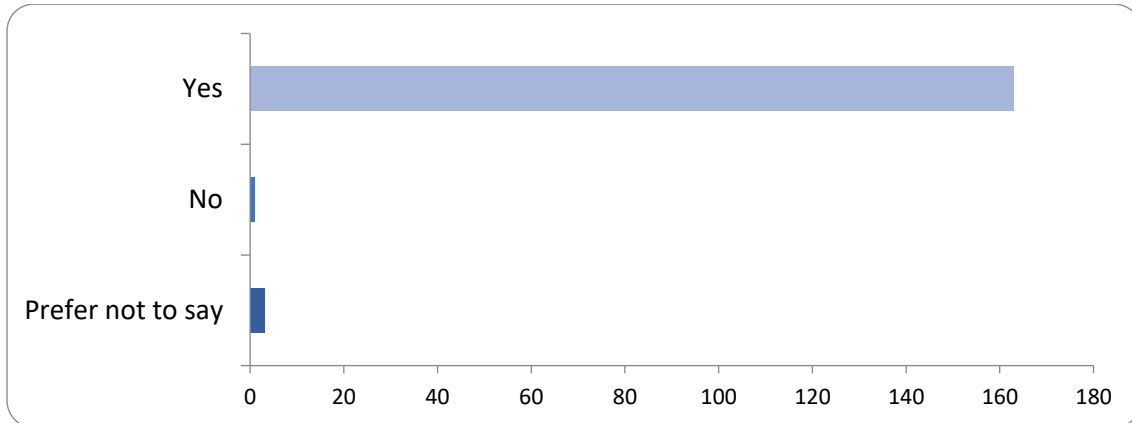


1.3 Please indicate what age bracket you fall under:



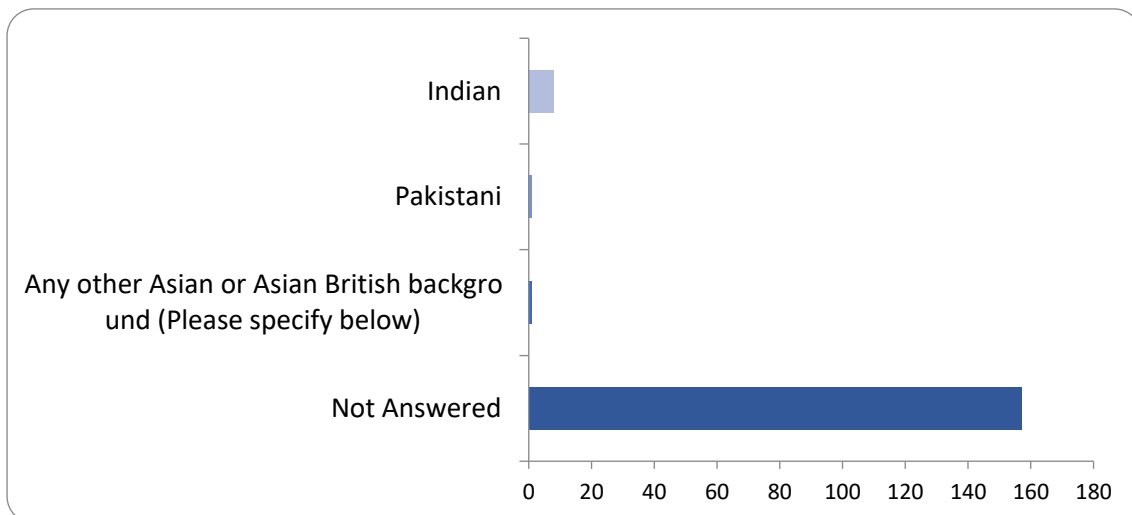
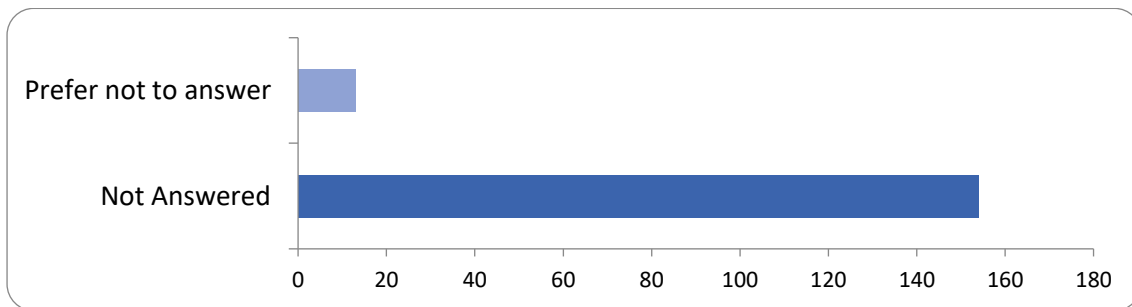

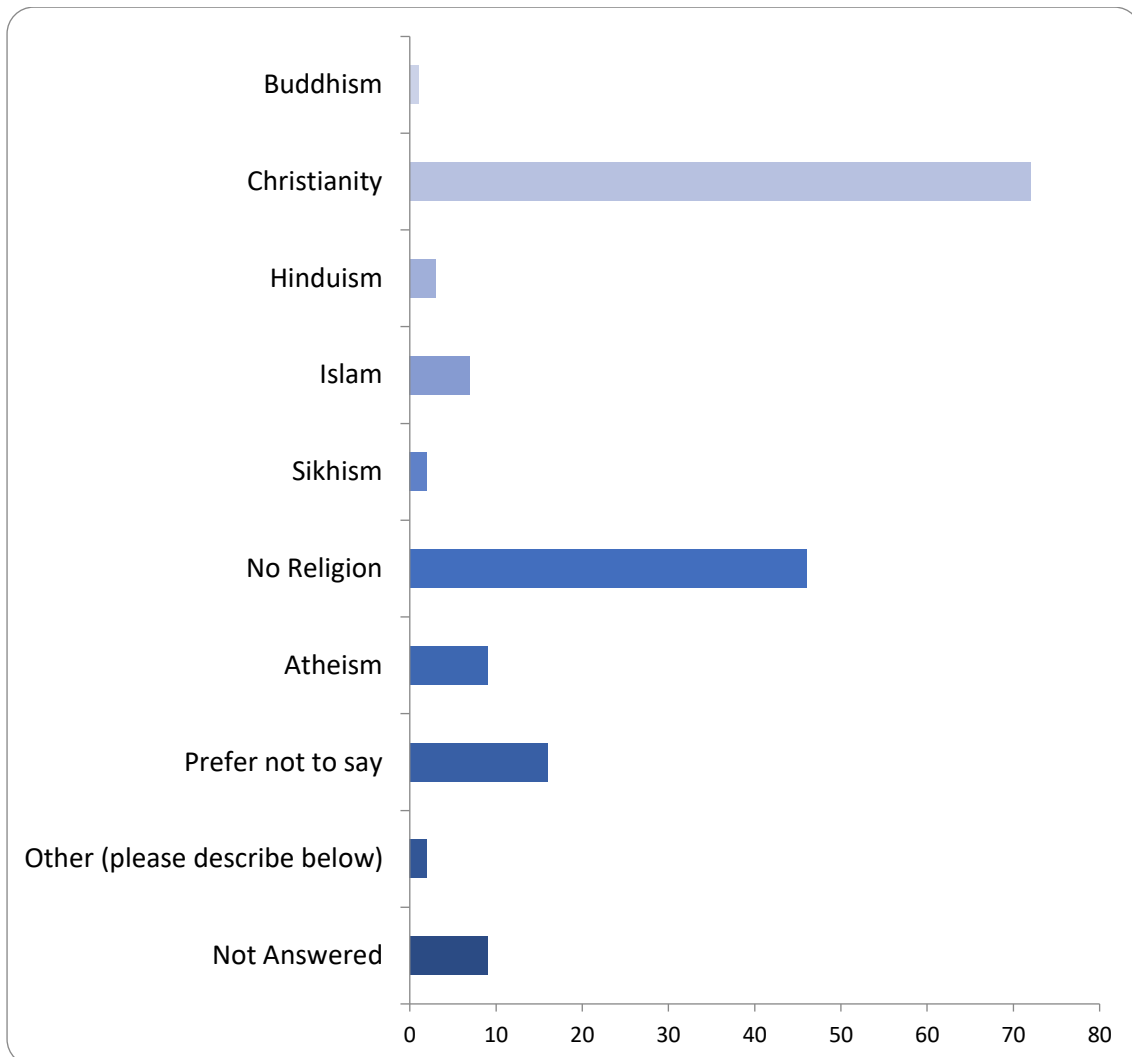

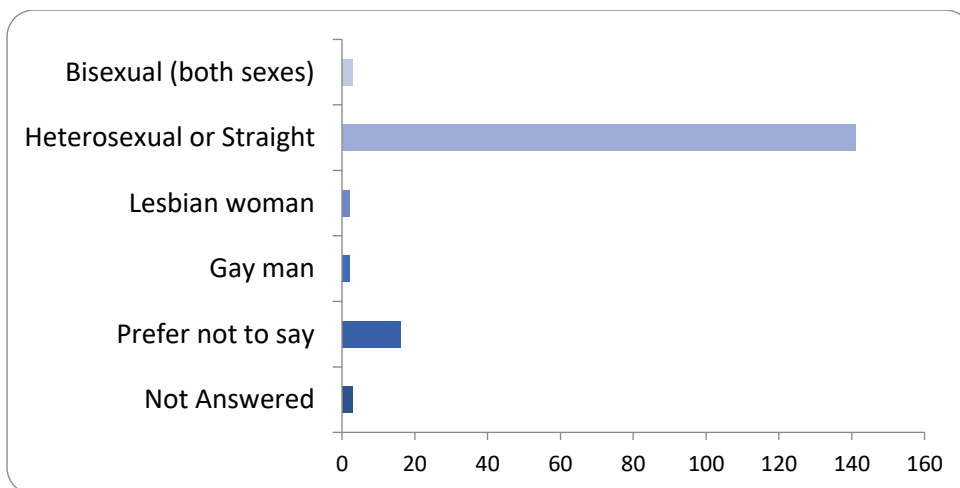
1.6 Do you consider yourself to have any religion?

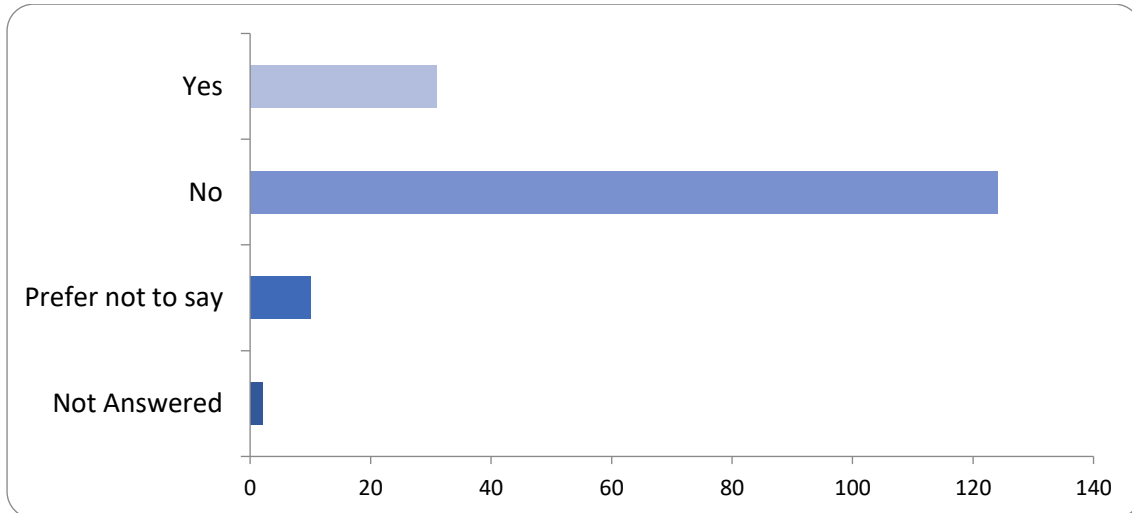
1.7 What is your sexual orientation?

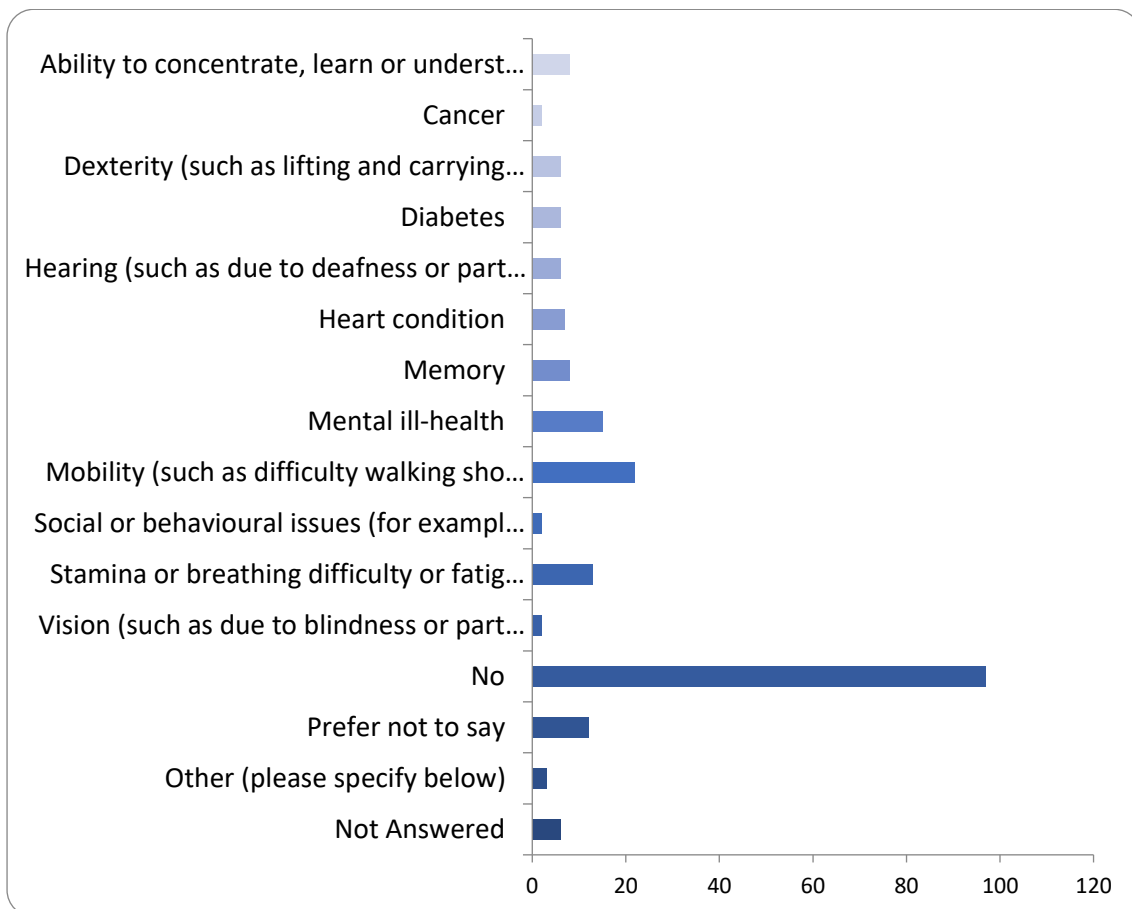
