

# BCG referral pathway for GP and Health Visitors

## **Updated December 2024**

From 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 babies eligible for neonatal BCG immunisation receive the immunisation around 28 days of age, rather than at birth. Eligible babies are those with a parent or grandparent born in a country where the incidence of TB is 40/100,000 or greater according to the World Health Organisation data. Maternity services are responsible for providing the dose around 28 days of age or up to 1 year of age if the dose is delayed for whatever reason.

Health Visitors, Practice Nurses and GPs should continue to check and identify eligible infants' BCG immunisation status in the early neonatal period. This includes checking immunisation status either at the primary visit or follow up contacts and at the 6-8-week GP developmental assessment. Should an eligible infant (aged 0 - 12 months) be identified who has not received BCG vaccination and does not have a clinic appointment booked, please refer to the appropriate provider using the contact details outlined in Appendix 1 - 9.

Eligible infants (aged 0-12 months) that have <u>moved in</u> to the West Midlands area or any children aged <u>12 months - 16 years</u> who are eligible as per the guidance outlined in the <u>Greenbook chapter 32 - tuberculosis</u> should be referred to the appropriate service using the contact details in Appendix 1 – 9. Please ensure when assessing eligibility the up-to-date resource <u>World Health</u> <u>Organisation (WHO) High Incidence Country List</u> is used.


