By embedding the use of Treatment Summary Records into the cancer pathway, Patients will be better informed and more able to self manage as well as improved awareness of signs and symptoms, managing consequences of treatment and reoccurrence.</p> <p>To encourage providers to proactively manage discharge through the use of Treatment Summaries which support self-management for patients and patient management in primary care.</p>

Treatment Summary have been developed to support improved communication between cancer services and primary care and patients

The Treatment Summary form should be completed at the end of primary treatment by the hospital and sent to the patient's GP with a copy to the patient. The form also includes the READ codes for the diagnosis and treatment so that the GP can update their patient database.

Completing a Treatment Summary is easier as it is available electronically on the two main cancer information systems Somerset Cancer Register and InfoFlex Cancer Information Management System

Patients should be given the Treatment Summary Record on discharge or as identified within data source inclusion.

Text highlighted blue is for local discussion and agreement
