All clinical staff trained to Tier 2/3 level, as appropriate



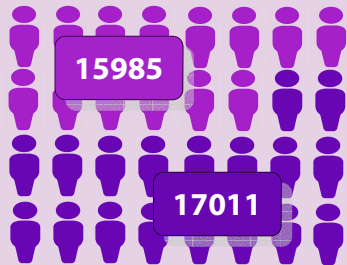
All care home staff trained to Tier 1/2 level, as appropriate



We are developing the role of care navigator to signpost and support patients and carers, avert crises, prevent unnecessary hospital admissions and facilitate timely discharge. An event on 13th October will assist in the planning process



We have mapped the competences required to care for people with dementia. We have worked with HEE to develop and implement an education and training package which is standardised and transferable



In 2012 the average diagnosis rate across Cheshire and Merseyside was 48.7%. We will increase the rate to meet the 67% target for 2015.



We will site memory services in both primary and secondary care, and aim for a maximum waiting time of 2 weeks.

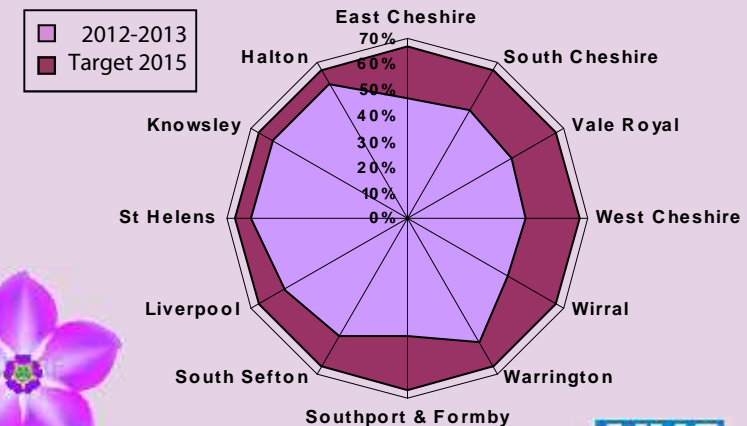


We are collaborating with colleagues across Northern England to ensure accurate data and a simplified coding system
