## **Psychological Care of Patients With Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) following Intensive Care Unit (ICU) Psychosis**



## Critical Care Rehabilitation and Follow up Team (CCRAFT)

Patients who have had an admission to ICU for more than 3 days are followed up on the ward by the CCRAFT. This team comprises of an outreach nursing sister, Consultant Intensivist, rehabilitation assistant and physiotherapists.

This shows some of the problems patients face post ICU:

Rehab begins during the patient's admission. Following transfer to the ward outreach includes Critical Care Outreach from the Nursing Sister and Rehab Assistant and Physiotherapists.

At three months post discharge the patient is invited to a follow up clinic.



This is facilitated by the consultant intensivist, physiotherapy and nursing staff.

The patient may have symptoms of PTSD or may be anxious and depressed.



Recovery may be taking much longer than they anticipated and the impact of disability and needing care and support are often very difficult to cope with and adjust to. This leads to a referral to the psychotherapist with no waiting list.

The psychotherapist is based in outpatients



with a service level agreement between the hospital and the mental health trust.



The patient is assessed for suitability



and offered Cognitive **Behavioural Therapy** or EMDR.
