- Service pressures are increasing

Suggested topics for discussion

- How to make appraisees see appraisal as something for them, rather than something for their organisation/the GMC
- How to recruit and support a body of appraisers who will facilitate this
- How to assess the quality of the appraisal process

Other issues that I have experienced that may be common to the acute sector

- Maintaining engagement at times of high operational pressure
- Aligning PDPs to service/corporate objectives
- Engaging transient staff groups
- Resourcing the appraisal process
- Managing poor appraisee engagement
