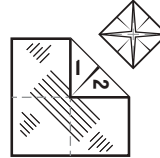
1) Cut paper into square, along cut line.



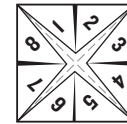
2) Fold paper in half length & width ways, then unfold back into a square.



3) Turn over so the plain side faces you and fold all corners inward towards the centre.



4) Flip paper over and again fold all 4 corners in towards the centre.



5) Fold paper in half across both diagonals, then unfold back into a square.



6) Bring all four corners up together whilst gently pulling the tabs out from underneath.
