In February 2020,
NHS Improvement
published an independent
report about some of the
work of Southern Health
NHS Foundation Trust.

The independent report said that another investigation should find out more about how the Trust had learned from previous reports.





This next investigation will be chaired by an independent Chair and Panel.



The independent Panel would like to hear from Southern Health service users to help the investigation.

The Chair will publish a report after the investigation.



### **Topics for the investigation hearings**



The independent Panel will focus on 6 different areas:

Asking whether a new process is needed to investigate complaints when they happen.





Looking at how complaints are responded to.

Asking how staff at the Trust communicate with families.





Looking at how well action plans that have been made to improve care are working.

Finding out how West Hampshire Clinical Commissioning Group is checking these improvements.





Asking about how the Trust has improved and whether more improvements are needed.

#### What the Independent Panel will do



The Panel will look at the way the Trust works in these 6 areas. They will make recommendations for changes if they are needed.

The Panel would like to hear from service users who have experience of Southern Health and these policies.





The Panel will <u>not</u> look into any personal cases or facts arising from your reply.

If the Panel need more information the Panel Secretary will contact you by Friday 12 February 2021.




You must send any extra information the Panel asks for by 4pm on Monday 22 February 2021.
