Update on payment for medical records movements

NHS England wrote to GP practices on the 22nd February to inform that NHS England agreed with the GPC to make a one-off contribution to GP practices based on a standard rate of £250 per practice. This payment is intended to recognise the additional workload and incurred since April 2016 with medical records. The 2017/18 funding settlement for general practice also includes an allocation relating to this.

Unfortunately the payment is not going to be made in April 2017 as anticipated as there have been some unexpected delays. NHS England is committed to ensuring that practices receive this payment as soon as possible and we will communicate out once the revised payment date is confirmed.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this but please be assured that we are working to address this as quickly as possible.
