This letter is to let you know that the NHS is putting arrangements in place to make sure you can continue to use the services provided by the Brighton Homeless Healthcare Surgery.

We know how valued the service provided by Dr Worthley and his colleagues at the surgery is and want to make sure you can continue to get dedicated and specialist care whenever you need it.

You may be aware that a healthcare organisation called The Practice Group currently provides your care at the surgery. They recently told us that they wish to stop running the surgery themselves and so we have been taking action to make sure that you can continue to get the care you need, as we know how valued this service is to patients.

We have now agreed with The Practice Group that they will continue to provide your care at the Brighton Homeless Healthcare Surgery until the end of January 2017.

This will give us the time we need to make arrangements with another healthcare provider to take over the running of the services provided by the surgery from February 2017. It will also give the NHS the opportunity to make sure we can to continue deliver the best possible care to you and to build upon the existing service you receive.

I hope that this provides you with reassurance about our ongoing commitment to your care.

The NHS will continue to work closely with Dr Worthley and staff at the Brighton Homeless Healthcare Surgery, as well as patients and local community groups as we develop plans for the new service. If you have any queries, please speak to reception staff at the surgery.
