1. CQC Rating Following Inspection	Outstanding/Good/Requires Improvement/ Inadequate	Yes
2. Satisfaction with opening hours	Above/Around/Below England average	Yes - component of composite indicator
3. Patients reporting confidence and trust in GP	Above/Around/Below England average	No
4. Cervical Cancer Screening (Smears)	Above/below England average	Yes
5. Flu vaccinations – Over 65 Age Group	Above/below England average	Yes
6. Flu vaccinations - Under 65 At Risk Group	Above/below England average	Yes
7. Childhood Vaccinations up to Age 2 (composite)	None – composite value	No
7.1. Childhood Vaccinations - Aged 1 DTaP/IPV/Hib vaccine	Above/below national 90% standard	No
7.2. Childhood Vaccinations - Aged 2 PCV booster vaccine	Above/below national 90% standard	No
7.3. Childhood Vaccinations - Aged 2 Hib / MenC booster vaccine	Above/below national 90% standard	No
7.4. Childhood Vaccinations - Aged 2 MMR vaccine	Above/below national 90% standard	No
8. Blood Pressure Management	Above/below England average	Yes
9. Atrial Fibrillation – Prevention of stroke	Above/below England average	Yes
10. Diabetes - Managing Blood Glucose Level (HbA1c)	Above/below England average	Yes
11. Cancer Detection Rate	None	No - uses emergency cancer admissions
12. Mental Health – Comprehensive Care Planning	Above/below England average	Yes
13. Dementia - Face to Face Reviews	Above/below England average	Yes
14. Antibiotic Prescribing	None	Yes
