

Safequarding is everyone's responsibility Who needs safeguarding?

Children: The Children Act 1989 and 2004 defines a child as anyone who has not yet reached their 18th birthday

Vulnerable or 'at risk' adults: The Care Act 2014 defines this as anyone over the age of 18 who: a) Has needs for care or support (whether or not the authority is meeting any of those needs. **b)** Is experiencing, or is at risk of, abuse or neglect, and c) as a result of those needs is unable to protect himself or herself against the abuse or neglect or the risk of it
