

## Quality and outcomes framework (QOF) 2018/19 extraction and calculations

This message contains important information about the Quality and Outcomes Framework (QOF) 2018/19 extraction and calculations.

Following the automatic extraction of QOF 2018/19 data beginning from Monday 1 April 2019, Achievement and Aspiration calculations are due to take place during Thursday 4 April 2019.

The calculations can take several hours to complete; this means that for most Service Providers, Achievements will be available to declare from Friday 5 April 2019.

Access to certain reports within CQRS will be temporarily disabled on 3– 4 April 2019 to allow the calculations to complete uninterrupted.

QOF data will be available in CQRS for Service Providers to review under the Data Submission tab.

**It is advised that all data is checked prior to Declaring QOF 2018/19 Achievements when they are made available.**

To check the extracted data under the Data Submission Tab –

- Log into CQRS
- Select the Data Submission Tab
- Select Quality and Outcomes Framework 2018/19 from the Quality Service dropdown list.
- Click on Achievement Date 31/03/2019
