Dental Patient Charge Uplift 2019.20

WMS: Dental Patient Charge Uplift 2019.20

To summarise, the dental charges will rise as follows and come into force on 1st April 2019:

- Band 1 course of treatment (and Urgent band treatment as specified) will rise by £1.10 in 2019-20, from £21.60 to £22.70
- Band 2 course of treatment will increase by £3.00 in 2019-20, from £59.10 to £62.10
- Band 3 course of treatment will increase by £12.80 in 2019-20, from £256.50 to £269.30

In addition the fee for replacement appliances for 19/20 has been confirmed as rising from £76.90 to £80.70.
