New measures to support development of safe COVID-19 vaccines

A raft of measures to allow the safe future mass rollout of a COVID-19 vaccine have been outlined by the government. The new rules and safeguards will strengthen the UK's ability to successfully deploy a UK-wide vaccination programme, which will be crucial in saving lives and bringing the current pandemic to an end. Further information is available on the Government website.

A <u>consultation</u> has been launched, which will look to amend the Human Medicine Regulations 2012 and will last 3 weeks, seeking the opinions and advice on the proposals from health experts and key stakeholder groups.

ACTION REQUIRED: CQRS – 2020/21 Seasonal Flu and Childhood Flu Service Offers

The Seasonal Flu and Childhood Flu 2020-21 Services have now been offered and are available for Practices to accept on CQRS. In order to limit the actions required around the enhanced service sign-up process this year, whilst you are responding to Covid-19, the service offers have been made in line with your sign-up in 2019-20. If you wish to amend your sign-up intentions please email england.primarycaremedical@nhs.net to confirm the changes, and the appropriate adjustments will be made.

Please log in to CQRS and accept these services as soon as possible and **by Wednesday 30 September 2020**, to ensure that you are included in the automated extractions.

IMPORTANT: Advance notice of CQRS downtime 18-22 September 2020

Please be aware that from Friday 18 September to the evening of the 22 September inclusive, CQRS will be offline due to system enhancements including the transition to cloud hosting. During this period, you will not be able to access CQRS for any purpose.
