About this bulletin

The NHS England and NHS Improvement (NHSE/I) South West Integrated Public Health Team has taken over responsibility from the NHSE/I South West Primary Care Team for collating and issuing a rebranded, weekly Public Health GP Bulletin. This weekly bulletin is the main method of communicating with practice managers covering the 579 practices in Bristol, North Somerset, South Gloucestershire, Bath & North East Somerset, Swindon, Wiltshire, Gloucestershire, Somerset, Devon, Dorset, Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly.

The bulletins contain important public health information for practice managers on Section 7a screening and immunisation programmes, which are commissioned by NHSE/I. Content may include requests for information and deadlines affecting payments, as well as updates on issues relating to GP contracts.

CQRS supplier change update, changes to service desk and CQRS welcome page

We advised earlier in the summer that NHSX is overseeing a programme to ensure the CQRS system remains in place to support efficient GP payments.

The contract with the current supplier will end on 31 October 2020. NHSX is working with the NHS Commissioning Support Units to bring the running, maintenance and development of the CQRS system in-house from 1 November 2020 onwards.

A structured transition between suppliers is in place to ensure the continued provision of the system without interruption for end users.

How users access and use the CQRS system is not changing and no action is required from practices or commissioners.

While the system itself will look and feel the same a new CQRS welcome page will launch 12 October. The new CQRS welcome page will have:

- User guides, manuals and service information
- CQRS news and development updates.
