## CQRS NOTIFICATION – 2021/22 NHSEI PUBLIC HEALTH COMMISSIONED SERVICES

### Now available for Sign Up on CQRS

This is a notification regarding the Public Health Section 7a Services that NHS England and NHS Improvement (NHSEI) would like to commission from you for 2021/22 via Calculating Quality Reporting Service (CQRS).

As part of the GP contract changes for 2020/21-2023/24 the following services have become Essential Services (ES) that form part of your core contract. #### **Automated collection**

- Meningococcal ACWY (MenACWY) vaccination programme 21/22
- Meningococcal B (MenB) infant vaccination programme 21/22
- Pertussis 21/22
- Pneumococcal PPV 21/22
- Rotavirus 21/22
- Shingles 21/22
- MMR 21/22
- Hepatitis B (newborn) 21/22
- Childhood 6in1 21/22

Please find attached a list of the service descriptions and payment indicators for the above services. NHS England will not be issuing Service Specifications for these services.

#### Please note the following important changes to the 2021/22 services:

- Hepatitis B 21/22 This service is now an automated collection
- **Shingles 21/22** Previously known as Shingles Routine & Shingles Catch Up and Shingles 21/22 now includes all eligible age groups.
- Childhood 6in1 21/22 New CQRS payment method.
   The Childhood Immunisation Target DES on Open Exeter was retired on 31 March 2021 and a new vaccination and immunisation domain in the Quality and Outcomes

Framework (QOF) will be introduced for 2021/22. The Childhood 6in1 21/22 service will be a £10.06 Item of Service (IOS) payment alongside the QOF.

Please note that Practices are still required to submit the Q4 2020/21 Childhood Immunisation Target onto Open Exeter by the 1<sup>st</sup> May 2021 and this will be the last submission.

Please note that new payment collection on CQRS for this service has been delayed to the 31 May. If you wish for April payments to be processed within May, you can submit April data manually, alternatively the data will be collected within the May collection.

#### 2021/22 Service coming soon

- PCV/Hib MenC 21/22 This will become an automated monthly collection (previously Manual entry & Quarterly). Please note this will be offered on CQRS for sign up at a later date to be confirmed..
- Seasonal Flu Service and Childhood Seasonal influenza services will be released later in the year.

#### Signing up to the 2021/22 services

You will have until close of play on Friday 07 May 2021 to sign up to these Essential Service programmes that now form part of your core contract.

Sign up on CQRS will enable you to claim payment against these services and the first collection is on the 9 May, so sign up must take place by 07<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

If you miss the cut-off date for the sign up you will miss the first collection for the programmes listed and will have to manually enter your data.

If you are planning on delivering these services to your patients, you must log in to CQRS and sign up as requested.
