Bowel Screening and Disability Registers

The NHS Bowel Screening Southern Hub will be writing to all GP surgeries in the South requesting lists of any individuals who are currently registered with a Learning Disability who are eligible for screening. This information will then enable the Screening Programme to send appropriate material in the form of easy read letters and leaflets to anyone being invited for Bowel Screening. In addition, additional support can then be provided for anyone needing to be referred for further tests. If you would like to send this information now then please provide Name, NHS Number and DOB for all those aged between 50-75 and with a Learning Disability to rsc-tr.BCSPSouthernHub@nhs.net

Please keep a look out for your letter and respond as soon as you can to ensure we can continue to support individuals invited within the NHS Bowel Screening Programme

To ensure that the information shared with the Southern Hub is accurate, please use this as an opportunity to review your LD registers to ensure all appropriate patients are included.
