## NHS Immunisation Programmes, MMR call and recall

Colleagues are asked to note that they may receive contact from parents following the final national MMR recall reminder that will be sent in the week commencing 30 January 2023 to the parents/guardians of children 12 months rising to 6 years and eligible for dose 1 and/or dose 2 MMR vaccine. A digital first approach will be adopted, and all communications should have been received by week commencing 13 February 2023. There is no change to the messaging in texts, emails or letters sent in early December 2022 when a 1st national recall was sent. The cohort receiving a final reminder in Jan/Feb will include those identified in September 2022 as eligible for national call and recall but not yet vaccinated, and children eligible from 27 January 2023, i.e., for some children the recall will be the last of 3 contacts and the 1st contact for those new to the cohort.
