MONTHLY CRITICAL CARE BEDS AND CANCELLED URGENT OPERATIONS
DATA, ENGLAND April 2018

Main Findings – April 2018:

Critical Care Beds

- There were 4,057 **adult critical care beds** available and 3,327 occupied, giving an occupancy rate of 82.0%. This is lower than the occupancy rate observed last month, which was 82.6%, and lower than in April 2017 (82.5%).
- There were 473 **paediatric critical care beds** available and 348 occupied, giving an occupancy rate of 73.6%. This is lower than the occupancy rate observed last month, which was 78.7% and lower than in April 2017 (78.9%).
- There were 1,419 **neo-natal critical care beds** available and 1,026 occupied, giving an occupancy rate of 72.3%. This is higher than the occupancy rate observed last month, which was 71.5% and higher than in April 2017 (70.7%).

Table 1 shows information on critical care bed occupancy from April 2016 to April 2018

Cancelled Urgent Operations

- The number of urgent operations cancelled was 238 in April 2018, which compares to 400 in March 2018, and 255 in April 2017.
- The number of urgent operations cancelled for the second or subsequent time was 16 in April 2018

Statistical Notes to Editors

1. Critical Care data

The figures on Adult Critical Care, Paediatric Intensive Care and Neonatal Intensive Care bed occupancy are “snapshot” figures taken at midnight on the last Thursday of each month. Therefore they will not reflect varying levels of bed occupancy through the day, week and month.

The figures include all staffed beds that meet the definitions of high dependency, critical and intensive care as specified in the published guidance. This could include beds that meet the specified criteria for this collection, but which are in hospitals that do not have formally defined or commissioned intensive care units.

NHS England commissions paediatric critical care nationally; further information is available via the Paediatric Intensive Care Audit Network

2. Data Quality

Monthly SitReps data has been collected and published since August 2010. Prior to August 2010, data was collected weekly and was un-validated management information.

Critical care data published until January 2011 should be treated with a degree of caution as data on Critical Care beds was published bi-annually in a separate collection until January 2011. Since February 2011, there has been a significant improvement in the coverage and accuracy of this data.

3. Data Availability

Monthly Sitreps data is published to a monthly timetable with data being published around 6 to 7 weeks after the end of the reference period¹. The next release of data for this collection will be 12th July 2018 (relating to May 2018). The full set of publication dates is described in the [12 months statistics calendar](#).

4. Revisions

Revisions to previous month's data are made in line with NHS England's revisions protocol for performance monitoring data. Future revisions will be made on a six-monthly cycle.
