The following statistics were released today by NHS England:

Bed Availability and Occupancy – Quarter ending 30th September 2018:

The KH03 is a Quarterly collection from all NHS organisations that operate beds, ordinary or day case. It collects the total number of available bed days and the total number of occupied bed days by consultant main specialty. The main findings are summarised below.

# **Occupancy Rates**

- The average occupancy rate for all beds open overnight was 87.3% in Quarter 2 2018/19 compared with 87.9% in Quarter 1 2018/19 and 87.1% in Quarter 2 2017/18.
- The average occupancy rate for general and acute beds open overnight was 89.1% in Quarter 2 2018/19 compared with 89.9% in Quarter 1 2018/19 and 89.0% in Quarter 2 2017/18.

## **Bed Numbers**

- The average daily number of beds open overnight was 127,305 in Quarter 2 2018/19 compared with 128,448 in Quarter 1 2018/19, and 128,139 in Quarter 2 2017/18.
- The average daily number of general and acute beds open overnight was 100,379 in Quarter 2 2018/19 compared with 101,259 in Quarter 1 2018/19 and 100,945 in Quarter 2 2017/18.
- The average daily number of available day only beds was 12,486 in Quarter 2 2018/19 compared with 12,480 in Quarter 1 2018/19, and 12,475 in Quarter 2 2017/18.
