

STATISTICAL PRESS NOTICE

The following statistics were released today by NHS England and NHS Improvement:

Bed Availability and Occupancy – Quarter ending 31st December 2019/20:


The KH03 is a Quarterly collection from all NHS organisations that operate beds, ordinary or day case. It collects the total number of available bed days and the total number of occupied bed days by consultant main specialty. The main findings are summarised below.

Occupancy Rates

- The average occupancy rate for all beds open overnight was 89.4% in Quarter 3 2019/20 compared with 88.0% in Quarter 2 2019/20 and 88.0% in Quarter 3 2018/19.
- The average occupancy rate for general and acute beds open overnight was 92.0% in Quarter 3 2019/20 compared with 90.0% in Quarter 2 2019/20 and 90.2% in Quarter 3 2018/19.


Bed Numbers

- The average daily number of beds open overnight was 128,329 in Quarter 3 2019/20 compared with 127,225 in Quarter 2 2019/20, and 127,571 in Quarter 3 2018/19.
- The average daily number of general and acute beds open overnight was 101,598 in Quarter 3 2019/20 compared with 100,406 in Quarter 2 2019/20, and 100,535 in Quarter 3 2018/19.
- The average daily number of available day only beds was 12,788 in Quarter 3 2019/20 compared with 12,957 in Quarter 2 2019/20, and 12,609 in Quarter 3 2018/19.
