## STATISTICAL PRESS NOTICE

The following statistics were released today by NHS England:

Bed Availability and Occupancy – Quarter ending 31st March 2023:

The KH03 is a quarterly collection from all NHS organisations that operate beds, ordinary or day case. It collects the total number of available bed days and the total number of occupied bed days by consultant main specialty. The main findings are summarised below.

It should be noted that bed numbers and particularly occupancy rates have been affected in Q4 2022-23 by the response to the Covid-19 pandemic.

# **Occupancy Rates**

- The average occupancy rate for all beds open overnight was 89.8% in Quarter 4 2022/23 compared with 89.7% in Quarter 3 2022/23 and 87.0% in Quarter 4 2021/22.
- The average occupancy rate for general and acute beds open overnight was 92.3% in Quarter 4 2022/23 compared with 92.0% in Quarter 3 2022/23 and 89.3% in Quarter 4 2021/22.

## **Bed Numbers**

- The average daily number of beds open overnight was 130,863 in Quarter 4 2022/23 compared with 129,857 in Quarter 3 2022/23, and 128,657 in Quarter 4 2021/22.
- The average daily number of general and acute beds open overnight was 104,543 in Quarter 4 2022/23 compared with 103,521 in Quarter 3 2022/23 and 101,975 in Quarter 4 2021/22.
- The average daily number of available day only beds was 12,631 in Quarter 4 2022/23 compared with 12,070 in Quarter 3 2022/23, and 11,911 in Quarter 4 2021/22.
