Rationale for inclusion

Involving patients in decisions about their care and is growing in importance and significance for *(add commissioners name)* both as a philosophy of care for our local health economy and in managing demand for healthcare. It is consistent with the growing focus on patient-centred care, 'no decision about me without me'.

Shared Decision Making is 'a process in which clinicians and patients work together to select tests, treatments, management or support packages, based on clinical evidence and the patient's informed preferences. It involves the provision of evidence-based information about options, outcomes and uncertainties, together with decision support counselling and a system for recording and implementing patients' informed preferences.'

Patient Decision Aids (decision support aids, decision support intervention, and decision aids) are specially designed information resources that help people make decisions about difficult healthcare options. These interventions seek to offer patients an understanding of the range of options available to them and the implications of those options.

It is our view that the benefits of Shared Decision Making are:

- Improved patient satisfaction, experience & knowledge
- Patients' ability to make choices in line with their own needs, values and circumstances
- Improved clinical outcomes and safety
- Achieving the right intervention rate and reducing unwarranted practice variation
