Title: Efficiency Controls Committee report

Purpose of paper:

- Report from the efficiency controls committee (ECC), in accordance with its terms of reference

Key issues and recommendations:

The Committee met six times in the period, approving 26 business cases without conditions and 15 with conditions prior to submission to the Department of Health (DH) for onward approval.

Work with DH to streamline approval procedures, and thus ensure an appropriate balance of tight control and responsiveness, is continuing.

Actions required by Board Members:

- The Board is asked to note the work of the committee.

Efficiency Controls Committee Report

1. The objective of the committee is to approve expenditure on activities relating to NHS England's functions that are subject to DH and Cabinet Office controls utilising, where appropriate, the delegated financial limits set out in the Standing Financial Instructions for members in attendance (the committee has no delegated budgetary authority of its own).
2. Following the establishment of the finance & investment committee (FIC), the ECC is focused on approval of short term revenue business cases, with FIC scrutinising long term commitments, capital and property related business cases as well as wider issues of financial policy, performance and budgetary control.
