We were pleased to see common sense prevail in 2013 only to see the indicators removed in 2014 when NHS England took over. The only reason I have seen is "simplification" but surely evidence is required rather than the "evidence free excuse" of simplification.

This decision was taken at a time where evidence is emerging evidence that the treatments for ED reduce mortality. I would firmly suggest that this simplification is already costing male lives at a considerable rate. If I am being unfair and there is a major trial or publication that I missed that supports the NHS England decision then I would be very keen so see this evidence.
