

# Equality and Diversity Council Meeting Paper 26 July 2016

## **NHS Learning Disability Employment – Update**

EDC Theme and objective (s) the paper links to:

Theme 3: Workforce Equality; Key Goals: Eliminating discriminatory practice Key Goals: the employment of people with learning disabilities in the NHS (with increased numbers of people with learning disabilities in the NHS)

#### Context:

July 2016 marks a year since the NHS Learning Disability Employment Initiative launched to:

- Significantly increase the number of people with global learning disabilities employed by the NHS
- 2. Lay the foundations for sustaining long term improvements in the employment of people with learning disabilities through leadership, partnerships, systems and processes

We have now gained the commitment of a significant number of NHS organisations and continue to work to create systemic change to enable NHS organisations to turn initial enthusiasm into meaningful employment opportunities.

1. Significantly increase the number of people with global learning disabilities employed by the NHS

#### Number of organisations pledging to participate:

The number of NHS organisations signed up to the NHS Learning Disability Employment Initiative pledge to employ people with learning disabilities now stands at 81 (see appendix A) and a map of pledges has been published on the NHS Employers website.

This number is comprised of:

• Providers: 64

• Commissioning Organisations: 14

National Organisations: 3

We continue to promote the pledge and most recently attended the NHS Confederation Conference to encourage NHS organisations to join those who are already signed up.



We are piloting extending the initiative to contractors and are working with the Department of Health and Mencap to enable Emcor to recruit people with learning disabilities to roles within the Department of Health offices they currently manage.

Of the national organisations represented at the Equality and Diversity Council, NHS England and Health Education England are the only organisations to of pledged.

Some national organisations are already employing people with learning disabilities, and all have signalled their commitment to the programme at the EDC.

## **Capturing Progress**

While a large number of organisations have now signed up to the pledge, many have found it challenging to progress to successfully employing people with learning disabilities. This is due to a variety of factors such as being unable to identify local support, having a lack of capacity within the organisation and 'the urgent overtaking the important'. We also know that there is likely to be more good work underway than we currently know of and that a number of organisations are continuing to progress plans to employ people this year. We have circulated a short survey to all organisations signed up to the pledge to ensure we capture their progress and understand where there may be emerging challenges we are not aware of.

2. Lay the foundations for sustaining long term improvements in the employment of people with learning disabilities through leadership, partnerships, systems and processes.

## **NHS Jobs:**

In partnership with the DH, we have begun the process of developing an easy read application form for the NHS Jobs website. These changes will make the application process easier for people with learning disabilities and has been a much requested improvement from NHS organisations looking to employ people with learning disabilities.

## **Apprenticeships**

While it is estimated that 65% of people with learning disabilities would like to be in paid employment, only 6.6% are currently part of the UK workforce. To help address this challenge the Government has launched a new taskforce to review how apprenticeships may be opened up to people with learning disabilities. We are ensuring that we remain linked in to this development and the subsequent implication for recruiting people with learning disabilities in the NHS. The initial findings of the taskforce are due to be published imminently.



## **Department for Work & Pensions**

We continue to build relations with the DWP and have met with the minister for disabilities to understand opportunities to support NHS organisations in employing people with learning disabilities. In talking to NHS organisations, we have identified a significant challenge in matching employment opportunities to the employment support available. The DWP is conducting a small number of pilots which aim to address this issue, matching up the voluntary sector, people with learning disabilities, and recruiters. We will explore opportunities to link up local NHS organisations with these pilot sites where possible.

## **Strategic Partners Programme:**

As part of the NHS England Strategic Partners Programme, we will be working with Mencap to connect NHS organisations to the local supported employment services available to them as an employer and increase the confidence of support organisations in working with the NHS.

## **Workforce Disability Equality Standard:**

We continue to ensure we remain linked in to Workforce Disability Equality Standard as it continues to progress.

## **Next Steps:**

In the coming months, our actions will centre around three aims:

- Continuing to increase the profile of employment of people with learning disabilities within the NHS through our active communications and system engagement.
- 2. Facilitating systemic change by continuing to build relationships with external partners.
- 3. Encouraging and enabling NHS organisations to turn initial enthusiasm into meaningful action.

#### Actions for EDC

- 1. EDC members to note the progress of the initiative and next steps.
- EDC members are encouraged to sign up to the learning disability employment pledge as well as encouraging NHS organisations in their networks to do so.
