

Patient Online - providing online access to test results

Why do it?

There are **many benefits** to patients viewing their test results online. Practices with more patients registered for online test results have found that this:



reduces calls and appointments from patients wanting to know their test results. stimulates the use of e-consultations and technology.





encourages greater involvement by patients in their care and there is the potential for earlier treatment as results are accessible 24/7. improves **patient satisfaction** by providing a more convenient way to access their results.



What if:	Please do:
Patients may not check their result and miss something that is abnormal.	 Review the workflow to ensure patients continue to receive any follow-up. Continue to adopt "recall" system for abnormal results. Ensure patients are informed that they need to check their results.
Patients see inaccurate or inappropriate results.	 Results should only be viewable by patients once they have been filed by clinicians. Adopt a process so that sensitive results are redacted or hidden as they are filed. INPS/Vision practices should consider disabling the auto filing functionality.
We get additional patient queries for abnormal results slightly outside normal range or that are normal for that patient.	 Patient will see coded actions and follow-up as part of normal access. Practices should consider offering free text access to provide more information to patient. Within EMIS this can be enabled just for results. In SystmOne free text provided in the "other" reason will be displayed to patient automatically.
