Title: Update on the National Improvement and Leadership Development Strategic

Framework

Summary:

This purpose of this paper is to share with the NQB, the current draft content for the national strategic framework on leadership development and improvement. This work is being jointly led by NHS Improvement and Health Education England on behalf of the National Improvement and Leadership Development (NILD) Board.

The document is intended to be a framework for action on skill-building, leadership development and talent management at local, regional and national levels. This is the first iteration of what is an adaptive framework by design. The intention is to release regular updates, adjusted and improved in the light of feedback and evaluation.

The NILD Board is next due to meet on 21 September 2016 to provide feedback and steer on the work to date and the current plan for publication of the Strategic Framework is at the end of October 2016.
