What should people know about you to make healthcare accessible?



You can take part in this workshop by talking, writing or drawing.

We will ask:



What you think NHS receptionists need to know about your support needs.



What you think healthcare staff (doctors and nurses) need to know.



What you don't want NHS receptionists or healthcare staff to know.



Morning workshop 2

What staff need to know about support for autistic people – to make healthcare accessible



This will be a discussion – you can say or write what you want to share.

We will ask:



What information would be useful to share about your support needs with NHS receptionists and healthcare staff?



Do you have any worries having information about your support needs on your health record?



Would you want your autism diagnosis shared with NHS receptionists and healthcare staff?

Morning workshop 3

How doctors can help people decide what information to share.



In this workshop we will talk and use role play. But you don't have to be good at acting!



Doctors need to ask your permission to share information about your support needs. They would do this using a 'flag' on the computer.



We will ask how you think they should tell patients about sharing information using a flag on the computer.

What are your experiences of how the NHS shares information about you?



For example when your GP shares information with a hospital about you.

We will ask about your experience of how information is shared between NHS staff.



We want to hear examples of when information about support needs has been shared well.



And we want to hear examples of when information about support needs has not been shared well.

This might be when information should have been shared but was not.

Or it might be when information should not have been shared but it was.

We will get you to design posters for the campaign.

This will help show us what you think the important messages are.
