  - 79.1 "The Contractor shall comply with the Data Protection Legislation and shall ensure that any contract with a sub-contractor will clearly set out the data processing relationship between those parties and the requirements on them to comply with the Data Protection Legislation."
- 3. Clause 79.2 is substituted as follows:

  - "Data Protection Legislation" means (i) the GDPR and any applicable national implementing Laws as amended from time to time (ii) the DPA 2018 to the extent that it relates to processing of personal data and privacy; (iii) all applicable Law about the processing of personal data and privacy;
- 6. Immediately after the **definition of "Dispute Resolution Procedure"**, the following new definition is inserted:
  - "DPA 2018" means the Data Protection Act 2018;
- 7. Immediately after the **definition of "Force Majeure Event"**, the following new definition is inserted:
  - "GDPR" means the General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2016/679);
