## Matters for the Board's attention

### Items for the Board's information and assurance

- 4. The Committee discussed Integrated Care Systems (ICS). Wave 1 ICS are showing improved financial and performance objectives in comparison to the NHS overall average and the benefits of a population health management approach
- 5. The Committee considered progress on the mental health programme, noting the progress across the breadth of the programme, a focus on health inequalities and a reduction in unwarranted variation. The Committed noted that the challenge will be to ensure that in the long term plan the NHS continues to strengthen its offer, meet demand and improve mental health outcomes.
- The Committee were updated on NHS continuing healthcare (CHC), noting the complexity of the policy area, the effective partnership with the Association of Directors of Adult Social Services (ADASS) and its contribution efficiency savings 2017/18 and 18/19.
- 7. The Finance report for month 6 was presented with the Committee noting better year to date position compared to same period in 2017/18.
