People with a learning disability can have a free flu jab. This is an injection that helps stop you getting the flu.

Carers can have the flu jab too.



You can have the flu jab from a nurse at your GP (your local doctor). Or you can have a flu jab at a pharmacy.



If you cannot have injections you can have a nose spray instead.
