
#### Introduction

1. The purpose of this paper is to inform the Provider Leadership Committee (PLC) of the work of the Non-executive Appointments Team (NAT) and to monitor the impact this has had on the overall diversity of the NHS trust non-executive community.

## Appointment activity Q3 2016/17

2. The table below breaks down the number and types of appointments made by NHS Improvement's PLC and sub-committees up to the end of the third quarter of 2016/17:

## Active recruitment campaigns

- 8. Work is currently underway to identify new chairs for the following NHS providers:
  - Hull and East Yorkshire NHS Trust
  - Maidstone and Tunbridge Wells NHS Trust
  - Barts Health NHS Trust
- 10. A list of current NHS provider chairs is included at Annex A. It includes information on the terms of office and current rates of remuneration, where these are known, and is sorted by region so that it can be shared with other NHS Improvement NEDs with regional oversight. A full list of current and upcoming chair and NED vacancies is also included at Annex B.

#### NHS provider board membership and diversity survey

- 11. The NED Appointments Team recently launched the "NHS provider board membership and diversity survey". This is the first comprehensive national survey of the composition and diversity of NHS provider boards, including information relating to a range of key protected characteristics.
- 12. The first stage of the exercise, to ask NHS provider board secretaries to provide details of the membership of their boards is now well underway, and 150 NHS providers have already responded. The outstanding 86 returns, which were due to have been returned by 7 December 2016, continue to be pursued. Progress is also being made on the second stage of the process; an individual email has been sent to all members of the boards giving them unique access to an on-line survey in which they will provide the more personal data being collected, in particular that related to their diversity.



## Regional chair network events

14. Details of the chair networking events held in Q3 are provided in the table below:

#### **NED** induction events

16.NHS Providers are now running 2 day induction events for newly appointed NEDs of all provider organisations. The first such event took place on 12/13 January 2017, with further dates confirmed throughout the year. Feedback from the January event is not available at the time of writing, but will be reviewed to ensure that NEDs are able to access an effective national induction programme within six months of being appointed.

#### **Update on remuneration issues**

18. The PLC asked to be kept informed of requests made to the Secretary of State for Health (SofS) to increase the remuneration paid to individual NHS Trust chairs. In November the Department of Health was asked to consider requests

to increase the level of remuneration payable to available to new Chairs of two Trusts in special measures:

- from £40,00 up to £50,000 pa
- Princess Alexander Hospital NHS Trust (PAH) from £21,105 up to £37,500

## **Purpose**

 The Provider Leadership Committee are asked to note the content of this paper which outlines the NHS Trust pay & severances cases that have been submitted to NHS Improvement for consideration over the past three months and have been reviewed by the Provider Leadership Committee and sub-Committee.

#### Issue

 During the period 1 October 2016 to 31 December 2016 the Provider Leadership Committee and its sub-committee have approved a total of 47 cases. These are broken down in the table below:




- 4. Further details of the 54 cases and 2 severance cases referred back to NHS Trusts can be seen in the attached spreadsheet across 4 tabs.


