Purpose

 The Provider Leadership Committee are asked to note the content of this paper which summarises the NHS Trust pay and severances cases that have been submitted to NHS Improvement for consideration over the past three months and have been reviewed by the Provider Leadership Committee and sub-Committee.

Issue

2. During the period 1st January 2017 to 31st March 2017 the Provider Leadership Committee and its sub-committee have approved a total of 40 cases. These are broken down in the table below:

- **5.** The NHS Improvement team has provided advice in some trust mergers, acquisitions or dissolutions as set out in annex 2 below.







Quarterly overview of the work of the Non-executive

Appointments Team

Introduction

1. The purpose of this paper is to inform the Provider Leadership Committee (PLC) of the work of the Non-executive Appointments Team (NAT) and is separated into the following areas:

- Appointment activity a breakdown of the NHS Trust chair, non-executive director (NED) and charity trustee appointments made by the PLC and its subcommittees during 2016/17, ongoing chair campaign activity, an outline of end of year reporting to the Commissioner for Public Appointments, and the restrictions imposed by the pre-election purdah period;
- Diversity overview which monitors the impact these appointments have had on the overall diversity of the NHS Trust non-executive community and highlights work on initiatives to understand and improve diversity across the whole NHS provider sector;
- Development an outline of the ongoing support for the NHS provider nonexecutive community, including a proposed review of the Code of Governance fit for purpose for all NHS providers.

Appointment activity

Appointments made in 2016/17

2. The table below breaks down the number and types of appointments made to NHS trusts by NHS Improvement's PLC and sub-committees for the full year 2016/17:

This demonstrates that the number of appointments remains high, despite the slow decrease in the number of NHS trusts to which these appointments are made.

Active chair recruitment campaigns

- 4. Work is underway to identify new chairs through open competition for the following NHS providers:

 - Lewisham and Greenwich NHS Trust

and is sorted by region so that it can be shared with other NHS Improvement NEDs with regional oversight. A full list of current and upcoming chair and NED vacancies is also included at Annex B.

Potential impact of the General Election Guidance


6. Formal guidance from the Cabinet Office on the handling of public appointments during the pre-election period has been issued. It states that "public appointments likely to prove sensitive (including those where Ministers have delegated decisions to officials or other authorities) should be frozen until after the election, except in exceptional circumstances". Greater clarity on the implications for the appointment of chairs and non-executive directors of NHS trusts, most of which could not be considered "sensitive" is being sought from the Cabinet Office and the NHS Improvement communications team. A verbal update will be provided at the meeting.



Update on remuneration issues


- 10. The PLC asked to be kept informed of requests made to the Secretary of State for Health (SofS) to increase the remuneration paid to individual NHS Trust chairs. In this Q4, Ministers have agreed the increases to the rates of remuneration paid to the chairs of the following NHS trusts:
 - Nottingham University Hospitals (from £23,600 to £40,000)
 - Barts Health (from £45,000 to £60,00 an additional £15,000 agreed for 2

- years for new chairs and linked to the achievement of strategic objectives set and measured by NHS Improvement)
- North Middlesex University Hospital (from £21,105 to £45,000 an additional £15,000 approved for fixed term of new chair after which it will revert to £30,000)
- Dartford & Gravesham (from £21,105 to £30,000)



Analysis of NED turnover

12.At its last meeting the PLC discussed the level of NED turnover on NHS trust boards and the potential reasons for resignations. Exit interviews were conducted with nine people with protected characteristics from across the country that stood down from their posts in the last 12 months. The NAT team explored the reasons for their resignation to potentially identify any recurring themes. Some of the feedback is provided below:




Diversity overview

Appointments made by NHS Improvement



20. In 2016 NHS Improvement decided to collect and publish a baseline assessment of the diversity relating to the membership of NHS provider boards as set out in Section 7 of the Business Plan 16/17. In December, the NAT launched the "NHS provider board membership and diversity survey" the first comprehensive national survey of the composition of boards across the NHS

provider sector, including information relating to a range of key protected characteristics. This data will enable NHS Improvement to focus effort to improve diversity where it is most needed and identify potential patterns in board leadership that impact on organisational performance. Progress to date is set out below:





Development

Regional chair network events

28. During 2016/17 the NAT held 13 regional network events for chairs. Feedback about these events continues to be very positive scoring on average four out of five with chairs valuing in particular the opportunity to network with other Chairs and hear from NHS Improvement. Details of the events held in Q4 are provided below:

NED Talk event

- 30. During Q4 of 2016/17 two events have been hosted by NHS Improvement to help NEDs explore some of the key issues and common agendas. Originally these events were exclusively aimed at provider NEDs but the potential audience has been expanded to include CCG lay members. It is hoped this networking opportunity between NEDs on providers and commissioners will help support working across organisational boundaries.
- 31. An event in January covered organisation culture and the way in which boards can influence it. Feedback from that event identified that Sustainability and Transformation Plans (STPs) was a topic NEDs were eager to explore further. The NAT worked with NHS England colleagues to deliver a further event on 28 March focussing on STPs, their governance, effective assurance mechanisms as well as influencing stakeholders in the wider system. Speakers were identified from three different STP footprints to share their experiences of moving their plans forward as well as a lot of opportunity for group discussion. The event was well attended with nearly 70 delegates and feedback for the overall event was 4.2 out of 5.
- 32. It is planned that in the future there will be better co-ordination between NHS Improvement and partner organisations to ensure that a range of development opportunities are available to the NED community.

Board Development sessions

- 33. Although this area of work has now passed to the Improvement Directorate, during 2016/17 the NAT commissioned NHS Providers to provide 10 board development sessions across the country on the following themes:
 - Developing an effective and compassionate unitary board
 - Recovering and maintaining performance
 - Delivering transformational change
 - From "needs improvement" to "good"
 - Working with the system to deliver transformational change
 - Developing a culture of continuous improvement to support high quality sustainable services

Appraisals

34. The 2016/17 appraisal round for NHS trust Chairs & NEDs is now underway. In line with last year's process Chairs have been asked to complete a self-assessment by 28 April which will be reviewed by the relevant Executive Regional Managing Director. Face to face appraisal meetings will be held if

appropriate.

35.NHS Improvement has asked chair to provide assurance that NED appraisals have been carried out by providing a summary sheet identifying the high-level outcome, any learning and development needs identified and confirmation that they are still suitable to hold the role. The returns should be made by 1 June 2017.

Non-executive induction events

36.NHS Providers are now running two day induction events for newly appointed NEDs of all provider organisations. The first such event took place in January 2017, with further dates confirmed throughout the year. Feedback from the first event was very positive, receiving an overall score of 4.5 (max 5) for the content of the event.
