

VARIATION OF TERMS OF ENFORCEMENT UNDERTAKINGS

BACKGROUND:

The variation is to reflect the abolition of the Referral to Treatment (RTT) admitted and non-admitted targets.

VARIATION:

The Licensee and Monitor have agreed the following variation to the terms of the Enforcement Undertakings accepted by the Licensee on 24 April 2015:

Paragraph 3.1 of the undertaking (RTT) is replaced by:

"The Licensee will take all reasonable steps to achieve compliance with the nationally defined incomplete pathway referral to treatment target on a sustainable basis."

This variation is agreed pursuant to paragraph 11 of Schedule 11 to the Health and Social Care Act 2012 (variation of terms).

All other terms of the original Enforcement Undertakings accepted from the Licensee by Monitor on 24 April 2015 remain unchanged.
