# Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the "FOI Act")

I refer to your letter of 23 February 2018, received by NHS Improvement on 26 February 2018, in which you requested information under the FOI Act from NHS Improvement. Since 1 April 2016, Monitor and the NHS Trust Development Authority have been operating as an integrated organisation known as NHS Improvement. For the purposes of this decision, NHS Improvement means Monitor and the TDA.

### Your request

You made the following request:

"I write to you with the request that you please provide a list of members (names and usual job role) of the high cost devices steering group, or any other affiliated group that has taken over responsibility for recommending which devices should be included or removed from the high cost devices list.

In addition to the above request, may you also provide the following documents outlined below:

- Please provide the dates of the forthcoming meetings of the group mentioned above
- Please provide copies of minutes of the last 3 meetings of the group mentioned above"

### **Decision**

NHS Improvement holds some of the information that you have requested and, subject to the redaction of personal information, has decided to release that material.

I consider some of the information requested is exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the FOI Act on the grounds that it amounts to personal data and the first condition under section 40(3)(a)(i) is satisfied, namely, that disclosure would amount to a breach of the first data protection principle (personal data should be processed fairly and lawfully) as the individuals concerned would have a reasonable expectation that their information would not be disclosed into the public domain. Section 40 is an absolute exemption and consideration of the public interest test in disclosure is not required.
