

## Trust Information

This survey portal is for submission of aggregated quarterly data for Indicator 1a (UTI) of the 2019/20 AMR CQUIN.

The 2019/20 AMR CQUIN has two parts:

1a: Improving the management of lower Urinary Tract Infection in older people

1b: Improving appropriate antibiotic surgical prophylaxis in elective colorectal surgery

2019/20 AMR CQUIN 1a indicator reviews the proportion of antibiotic prescriptions for patients who are being treated for a lower UTI and are compliant with national guidance in terms of diagnosis and choice of agent. The CQUIN states that Acute Trusts should undertake a local audit using a sample size based on the number of patients who are coded as having treatment for a lower UTI during each quarter. The first 100 patients should be audited. Patients do not have to be randomised.
