



Primary care triage UTI form for patients presenting with UTI symptoms

New symptoms (2 or more may indicate a UTI)
Lower back pain or pain in side
A sense of urgency to go to the toilet or a new incontinence
Needing to urinate more often than normal
Any pain in lower tummy or above the pubic area
Any blood in the urine
Any pain when passing urine
New fall or an increase in falls that may indicate the start of an infection
Feeling hot/sweaty or has a temperature

- If only one symptom or less give UTI leaflet for self-care advice
- If 2 or more symptoms give MSU leaflet and ask for a urine sample.
- ***If a patient requests a urine pot for an outpatient appointment, please advise that this will now be supplied by the hospital on arrival to their outpatient appointment.**
