How have stakeholders been involved? What engagement methods have been used?	<p>Policy working group meeting and subsequent contact for policy development.</p> <p>Stakeholder engagement process. 14 day email engagement exercise with registered stakeholders.</p>
What has happened or changed as a result of their input?	<p>Some wording to the policy proposition has been amended to incorporate another Quality of Life measure and to incorporate “smoking cessation” as an intervention and the proposal now includes a reference to pulmonary rehabilitation.</p> <p>The PWG noted that not all clinicians agreed with the criteria for selection but it does reflect clinical consensus.</p>
How are stakeholders being kept informed of progress with policy development as a result of their input?	<p>Stakeholders will be kept informed of the policy’s progress through NHS England’s consultation portal website.</p> <p>Stakeholders who sent in comments have had an email response.</p>
