**Update to the GP contract agreement 2021/22-2023/24: Financial implications**

The letter of 21 January outlined that NHS England and NHS Improvement and the General Practitioners Committee of the British Medical Association had agreed an initial set of GP contract arrangements for 2021/22 - and provided a summary of the changes. That letter is available at:

Although you may be aware of some financial implications from the first letter (see Appendix A), I'm setting out details of all the financial implications to date – an additional £257m for General Practice in 2021/22 - so you have them all in one place.

The letter of 17 June outlines new Enhanced Services for Weight Management and Long COVID. Together with the additional funding set out in Appendix A, this means that CCG allocations for 2021/22 will be as follows:

A summary of what these amounts are intended to fund is set out overleaf.

- The Weight Management Enhanced Service outlined at paragraph 5 and detailed at Annex A of the [Update to GP contract arrangements for 2021/22](#) will be paid at £11.50 per patient living with obesity who is referred to eligible weight management services. Payments under the scheme will be made monthly by commissioners, via a manual payment. The funding shown in the table above will be allocated to CCGs on the basis of practice claims paid in the quarter.
- The Long COVID Enhanced Service is outlined at paragraph 6 and detailed in Annex B of the [Update to GP contract arrangements for 2021/22](#), with practice payment based on registered list sizes as at 1 January 2021. (unless a later date has been agreed with the commissioner). Practices are entitled to 75% of their total entitlement on sign-up to the service, payable monthly. The remaining 25% will be paid on commissioner confirmation that the declaration set out in Annex B, paragraph 8, has been completed by 31 March 2022. Appendix D shows the CCG allocations for this Enhanced Service.

Coding requirements for these payments will be circulated through the Primary Care Finance Group.


CCG allocations of the £32.5m additional funding for PCN clinical directors up to 30 September will, as is currently the case, be calculated locally by CCGs based on PCN eligibility and claimed through their regions.

Importantly, the drawdown of ARRS funding is conditional on the use of NWRS by all PCNs and the timely submission of PCN claims through the portal. Further information to support last year's [letter](#) for CCGs claiming additional funding will be issued shortly.

## Appendix A

### Additional funding allocations from the initial set of 2021/22 contract arrangements

CCG Primary Medical Care baseline allocations have been uplifted to take account of the additional funding shown in the table below. This follows the 25<sup>th</sup> March publication of the [Guidance on Finance and Contracting Arrangements for H1 2021/22](#), and allocation details and supporting information cascaded via regions on 29 March. The detailed Primary Medical Care local allocation adjustments by CCG area are attached at Appendix A.

A summary of what these amounts are intended to fund is set out below.

- The Care Home Premium described at paragraph 11 of the [2020/21 Contract update document](#) will be paid at £120 per CQC-registered care home bed per year. The funding shown in the table above will be distributed to CCGs on the basis of the number of care home beds in their area. Published CQC data<sup>1</sup> on bed numbers in each CCG area will inform the calculations.
- “Increase in Practice funding relating to the 2020/21 contract agreement” shows the net effect of the £10m increase in QOF, described in paragraph 9 of the 2020/21 Contract Update document, and £12m for post-natal checks described in paragraph 10. This is partly offset by the end of a time-limited funding stream worth £2m related to Primary Care Support England (PCSE), which is now removed.
- New QOF indicators from 2021/22 are described in paragraph 7 of the [21 January letter, which](#) covers:
  - £58m transferred from section 7a funding for the Childhood Immunisation DES to help improve payment arrangements; and
  - £24m to strengthen the serious mental illness (SMI) physical health check indicator set and support uptake.
- Following its commencement as part of the 2020/21 Network Contract DES, the Investment and Impact Fund (IIF) will continue in 2021/22. An initial six indicators worth a total of £50.7m commenced from 1 April, rewarding PCNs for:
  - delivery of seasonal influenza vaccination (for over 65s, patients aged 18-64 in a clinical at risk group, and children aged 2 to 3 years);
  - annual Learning Disability Health Checks and Health Action Plans;

- social prescribing referrals; and
- the mapping of appointment categories to new national categories by the end of Q1 2021/22.

Further indicators will be added to the IIF in the second six months of 2021/22 and in future years. Funding allocations for these years are shown as “TBC” (To Be Confirmed) here, pending the outcome of further negotiations on the total value and metrics. It will be funded through additional allocations for commissioners.

This does not include additional funding for the Additional Roles Reimbursement Scheme for which separate arrangements apply - and are explained below.

### Funding the costs of other contract increases

Published allocation increases cover the additional costs of:

- increases to global sum - which include:
  - amounts in respect of increases to contractor pay, staff and other expenses; and
  - the reinvestment of reductions to seniority costs.
- the introduction of the new QOF indicators described above for vaccinations and immunisations and also changes to the value of a QOF point to reflect the changing average practice size.

### Enhancing the Additional Roles Reimbursement Scheme (ARRS)

As set out in chapter 1 of the [2020/21 contract update document](#), the ARRS has been expanded with the aim of delivering 26,000 extra staff by 2023/24. Accordingly, a further three roles have been added from 2021/22. CCGs are expected to have at least 15,500 FTE in place by the end of 2021/22.

Additional resources are being made available for the ARRS as shown at row (B) of the table below to give total funding of £1,412m by 2023/24.

The original ARRS funding, at row (A) in the table, is already included in the Primary Care Medical allocations<sup>2</sup> published on 17 July 2019. In 2021/22, this funding is worth £415m across England, which is around 56% of the £746m total available.

The additional ARRS funding, shown at row (B) of the table, which is worth £331m in 2021/22, will, in the first instance, be held by NHSE&I and not added to the revised local Primary Care Medical allocations.

The intention, as it was for 2020/21, is that as PCNs claim ARRS reimbursement in 2021/22, and subsequent years, so the funding shown in row (A) of the table that is included in local Primary Care Medical allocations will be paid out by CCGs.

At a CCG level, once the funding in row (A) has been claimed by PCNs and they continue to claim reimbursement over those amounts, CCGs will be able to draw down additional allocations - on the basis of need - from the centrally-held additional funding shown in row (B).

The details of the initial draw down arrangements for 2021/22 were communicated in early April via regional finance colleagues. PCNs must make timely claims for their ARRS workforce via the [mandatory online claim form](#) and CCGs will not be eligible to draw down additional funding without evidence that PCNs have made claims via this process to a level commensurate with the CCG's initial allocation. The value of the funding in row (B) for each CCG is included in Appendix C.
