# Minimising Clostridioides difficile and Gram-negative Bloodstream Infections

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# Introduction

The NHS Standard Contract 2021/22 includes quality requirements for NHS trusts and NHS foundation trusts to minimise rates of both *Clostridioides difficile* (*C. difficile*) and of Gram-negative bloodstream infections to threshold levels set by NHS England and NHS Improvement. The thresholds for each trust, together with the methodology used to identify these, are set out in this document.

Although it does not form part of NHS Standard Contract requirements, it is also important that there is a focus across local health economies on reducing infection levels. The tables in this document therefore also show threshold levels for the same infections at clinical commissioning group (CCG) level. In contrast to the thresholds for trusts which only include healthcare-associated cases, the CCG thresholds encompass total cases.

- All thresholds are derived from a 2019 calendar year baseline, to avoid capturing changes related to the pandemic.
- Thresholds are presented as counts. Rates are not presented due to changes in hospital bed days seen since the start of the pandemic.
- Trust-level thresholds include healthcare-associated cases only, CCG-level thresholds include total cases.
- Complete data on healthcare association for Gram-negative bloodstream infections is not available in the healthcare-associated data capture system (HCAI DCS) for the 2019 calendar year. Therefore, healthcare association was determined through data linkage with the admitted patient care records of the hospital episode statistics database (HES), which provided information on the patient's prior admissions. Note that the admitted patient care HES record does not include outpatient admissions.
- Complete data on healthcare association for *C. difficile* infections is available in the HCAI DCS for the 2019 calendar year. Therefore, healthcare association was determined using data provided by the reporting NHS acute trust.
- Healthcare association relates to inpatient admissions only.

- 2019 calendar year baseline data will not match data previously published by Public Health England due to subsequent revisions to data submissions to the HCAI DCS, as well as the data linkage with admitted patient care records for Gram-negative bloodstream infections.
- All target counts were rounded down to the nearest whole number.
- Further releases will be made available that account for trust and CCG mergers that occur later in the financial year.

## Trust Thresholds

Trusts are required under the NHS Standard Contract 2021/22 to minimise rates of both *Clostridioides difficile* (*C. difficile*) and of Gram-negative bloodstream Infections so that they are no higher than threshold levels set by NHS England and Improvement. The following table sets out the threshold levels for each trust.

### **C. difficile – trust thresholds**

- If a trust had less than or equal to ten cases during the 2019 calendar year the threshold will be equal to that count. If a trust had more than ten cases the threshold will be one less than the count.

### **Gram-negative bloodstream infection – trust thresholds(*E. coli*, *Klebsiella spp.*, and *P. aeruginosa*)**

- For each of the three Gram-negative bloodstream infection types specified, if a trust had less than or equal to ten cases during the 2019 calendar year the threshold will be equal to that count. If a trust had more than ten cases the threshold will be 5% less than the count.
