Diagnostic radiographers - NHS Occupation Codes are S*F.

Diagnostic radiographers produce and process images of body structures to support the diagnosis of disease and skeletal and soft tissue abnormalities as a result of trauma or disease. Images are also produced to support and guide direct interventional treatments, procedures, and therapies. Radiographers use a variety of imaging techniques, including x-ray; computed tomography (CT); magnetic resonance (MR); ultrasound. Radiographers work directly with patients, supporting them before, during and after the imaging process. Patient safety, and especially radiation safety, are key responsibilities for radiographers. They also collaborate closely with the doctors who request examinations and the radiologists who report on them. A subset of diagnostic radiographers can also report on images.

Therapeutic Radiographers - NHS Occupation Codes are S*G.

A therapeutic radiographer is an allied health professional (AHP) who has undergone specific training to be able to deliver radiotherapy for patients undergoing treatment for cancer. It is compulsory for radiographers to be registered with the Health Professions Council (HCPC). Only HCPC registrants can practice as therapeutic radiographers in the UK. The role of the therapeutic radiographer involves managing the treatment pathway, providing the technical expertise and support while delivering accurate radiotherapy treatment. The duties vary from performing a planning CT scan and being involved in treatment planning to the delivery of radiotherapy.

Any other staff (e.g. sonographers)

Trusts should use this field to record staff taking strike action in other professional groups. This may include Sonographers and Nuclear Medicine Radiographers, or other SoR members eligible to strike.
